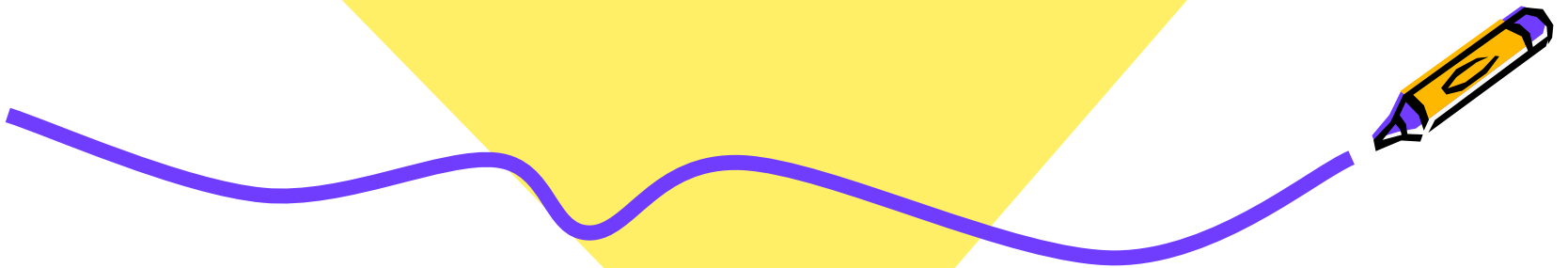

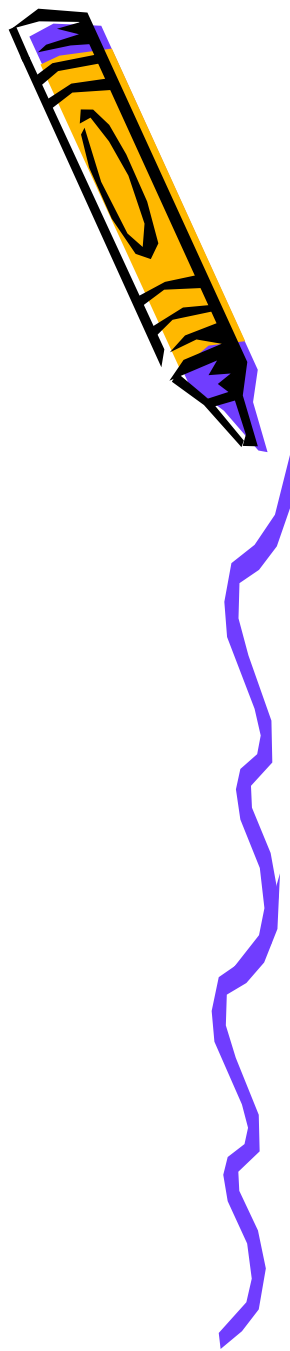
Days and weeks.

- So what are the days of the week in English?



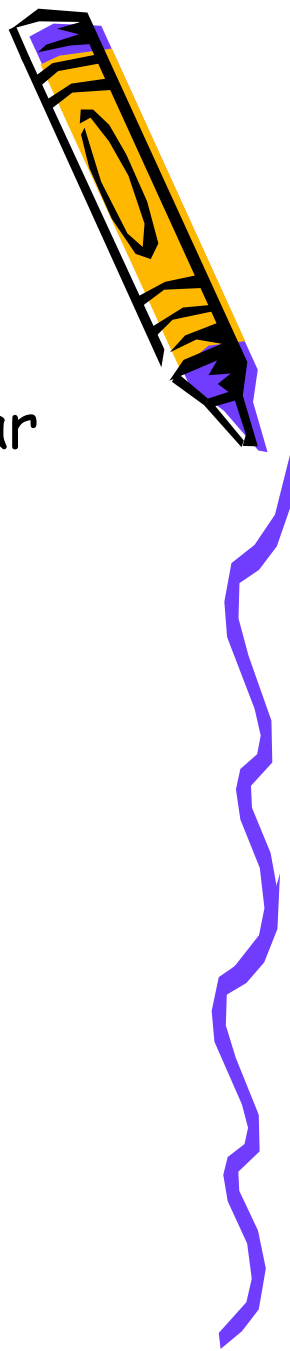
The names of the different days.

- Sunday

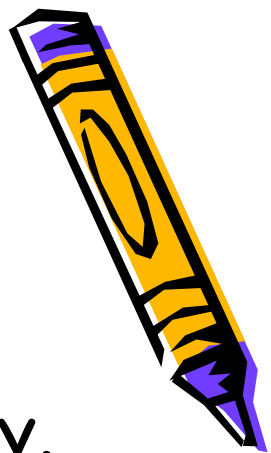


Ordinal numbers

- The third day is Tuesday.
- The fourth day is Wednesday
- The fifth day is Thursday.
- The sixth day is Friday.
- The seventh day is Saturday.

- When is another word we can use to ask questions.

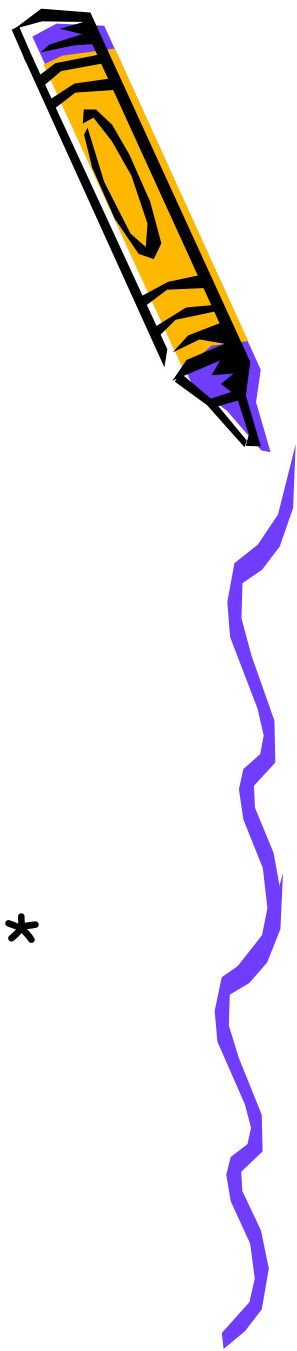


Practice:

- I was born in 1972 (the year of my birth).



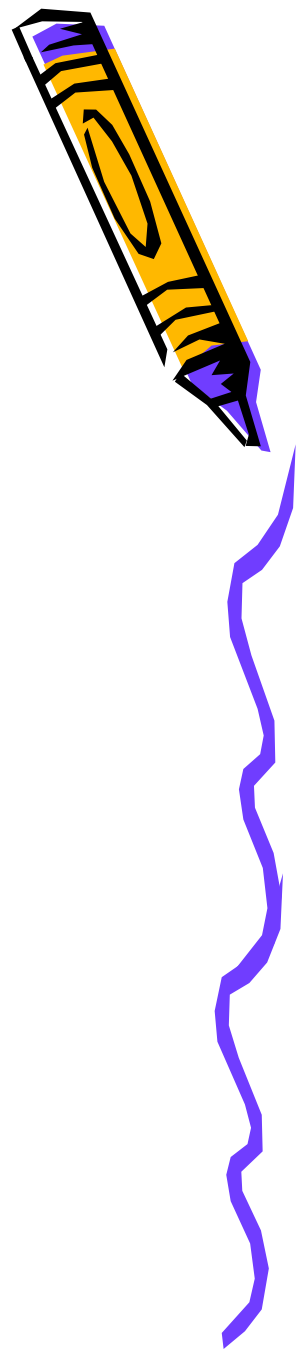
Practice.
