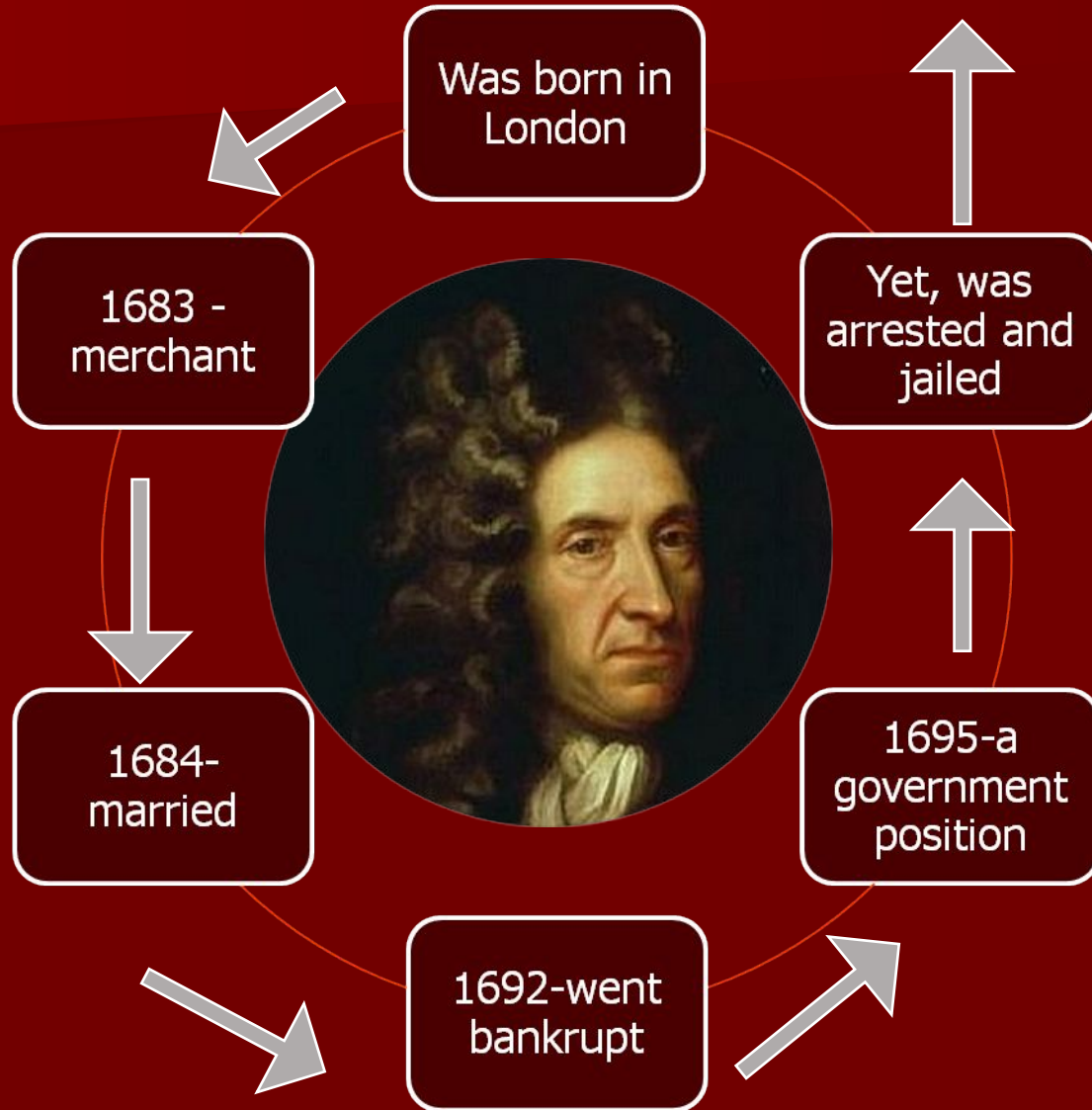

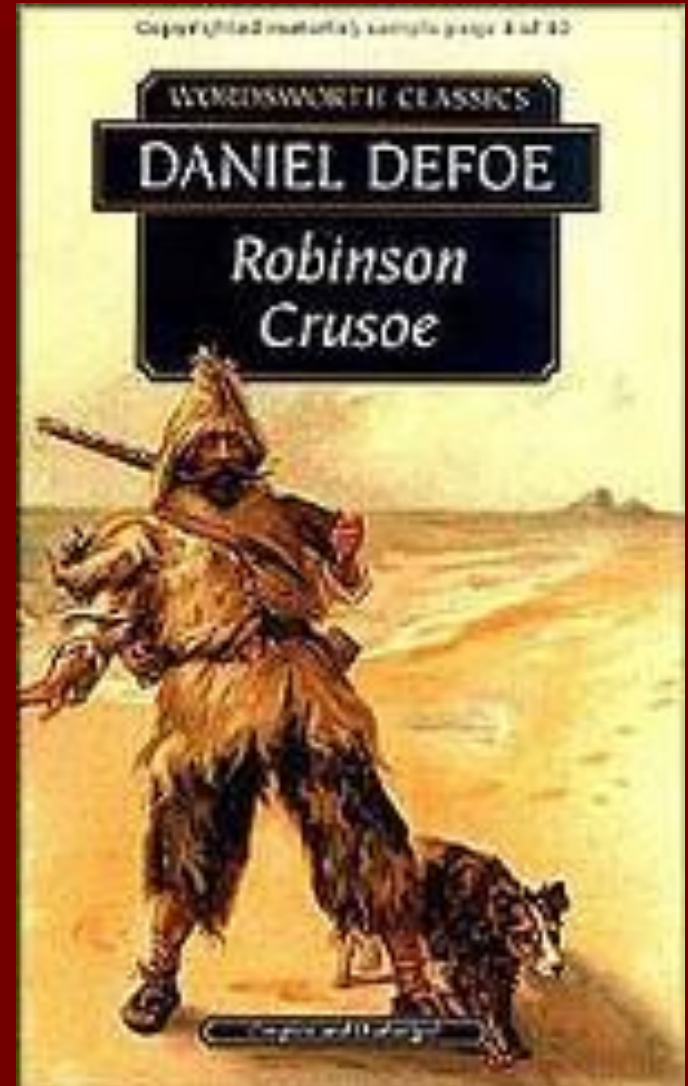

Contribution to literature

- He created famous novel “Robinson Crusoe”. The novel marked the beginning of realistic fiction as a literary genre.
- His another famous works are: *A Journal of the Plague Year*(1722), *Roxana*(1724), *The Family Instructor*(1725), *A Tour Through the Whole Island of Great Britain*(1724-1727), *The Complete English Tradesman*(1725-1727), *A General History of the Pirates*(1724-1728).
- D.Defoe is true inlightment and he's the main writer of this literary trend.



“Robinson Crusoe”

- He was the son of German merchant in England.

Friday, Robinson's friend
