Blended learning is a mix of traditional, distance and online technologies.

Point 1. The characteristic of blended learning

Structure of blended learning:

“Before”

A student must be ready to discuss the material of the lesson with tutor and other students. (self-preparing)

“During”

Discussion the troubles, asking questions, doing tasks.

“After”

Doing home-task, working on a project and etc. A tutor consults the students and answers questions.
