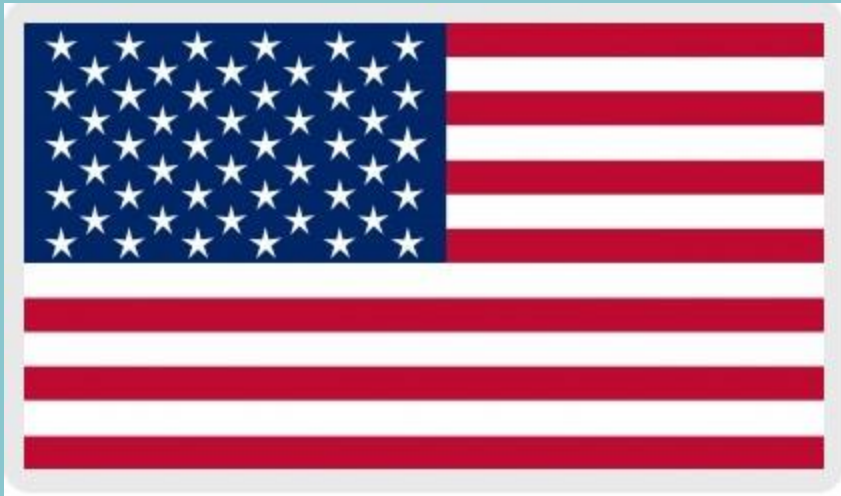

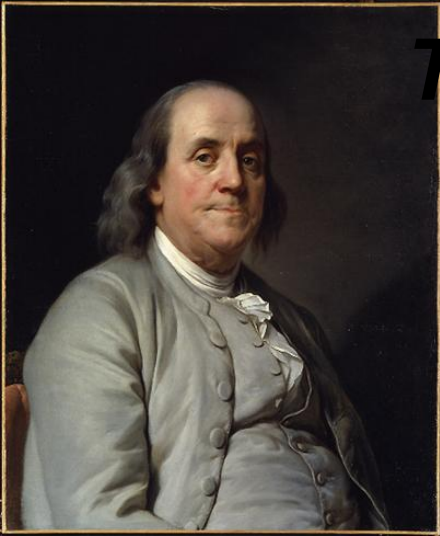

(1706 –1790)

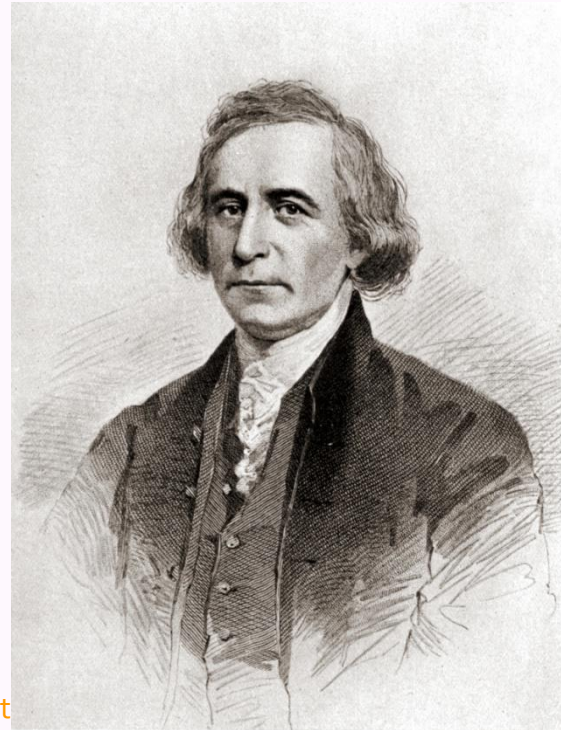

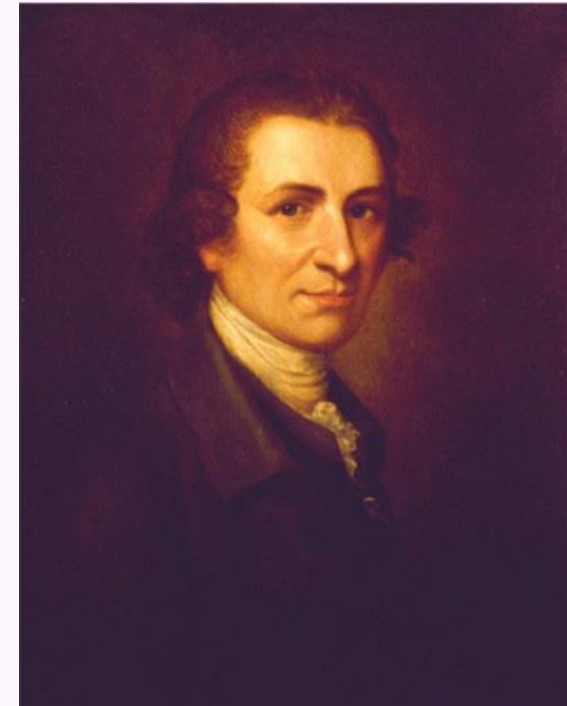

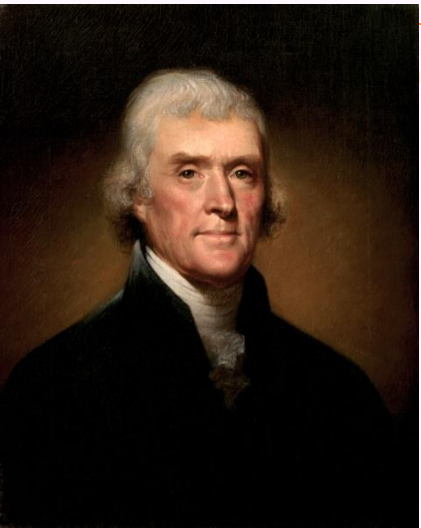


Philip Freneau (1752 –1832)

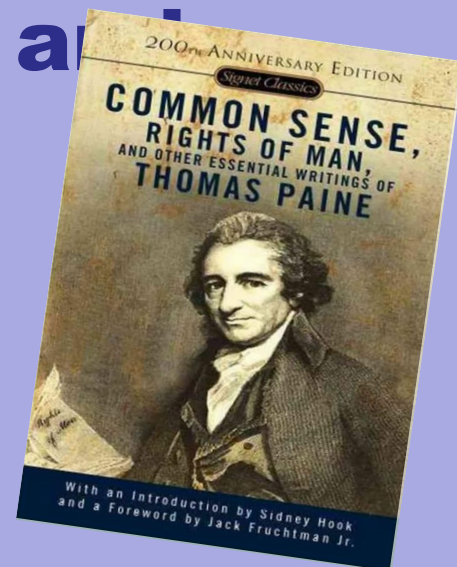
Thomas Paine (1737 –1809) was an English-American political activist, author, political theorist and revolutionary.
