The Present Simple Tense

Для времени *Present Simple* характерно употребление следующих наречий:

- **Always** – всегда *She always reads this book*
- **Usually** – обычно *I usually go to school by bus*
- **Sometimes** – иногда *They sometimes watch TV*
- **Often** – часто *He often sings new songs*
- **Seldom (rarely)** – редко *We seldom visit this place*
- **Every day** – каждый день *You walk with your dog every day*

I work	Do I work?	I don't work
You work	Do you work?	You don't work
He works	Does he work?	He doesn't work
She works	Does she work?	She doesn't work
It Works	Does it Work?	It doesn't work
We work	Do we work?	We don't work
You work	Do you work?	You don't work
They work	Do they work?	They don't work
