


Nosy Personal Questions Related to the Reading & Study of the novel <u>Fahrenheit</u>



 Please respond to the following questions without identifying anyone from your answers.




- 1. How many hours of TV do you watch per week? Figure this by adding up approximately how many hours per day you watch.
- 2. How many hours do you spend listening to music per day? Include time with the radio on or your MP3 player.

- 4. How many hours of video games do you play per week?
- 5. How many hours per week do you spend on the computer?
- 6. How many books have you read in the last 6 months? Do not include books you had to read for school.



- 7. How many hours during your waking time do you spend not interacting with the media per week (no music, TV, computer, cell phones etc.)? Do NOT include school time!
- 8. How many hours per week do you spend on homework?
- 9. Do you listen to music or watch TV when doing homework or studying?
- 10. Have you ever memorized a radio or TV jingle? How about a TV theme song? If so, give an example. Did you intentionally try to memorize this?
- 11. At the current rate of growth in size and quality, what do you think TV screens will be like in the future?
- 12. What are the three favorite topics of conversation among you and your friends?



- 13. How many, or what percentage, of your peer group do you know to have been involved in a violent incident? (a fight, a car accident, etc.)
- 14. What percentage of your friends do you think have been involved in some form of vandalism?
- 15. Do you know any people who have had an abortion?
- 16. What percentage of people in your peer group do you know use recreational drugs?
- 17. What percentage of people do you know use legal drugs to control stress, anxiety or depression?
- 18. Do you know anyone personally who has tried to commit suicide?



- 19. Think of your five closest neighbours. Using a scale of 1 to 10, how well would you say you really know them?
- 20. On a scale of 1 to 10, how well do you understand each of the following:
 - a. The policies of the current provincial government
 - b. The policies of the current federal government
 - c. Canada's foreign policy
