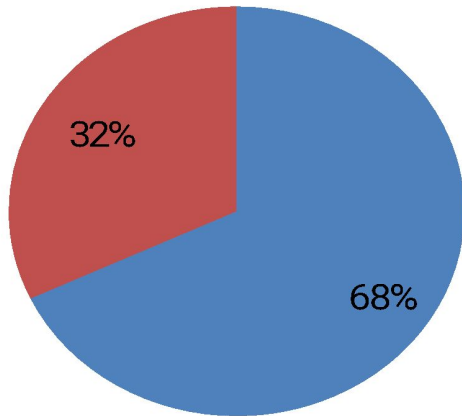

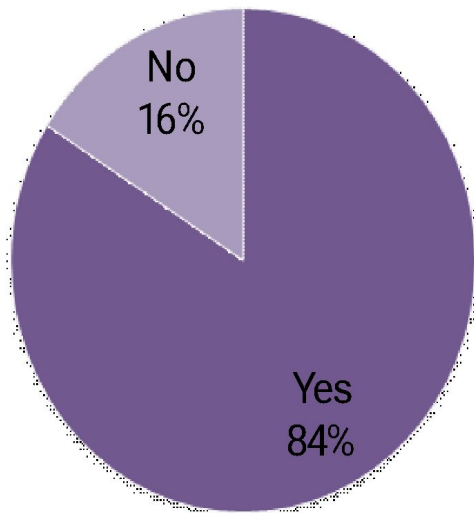
Result of survey.

68% - Live without parents.

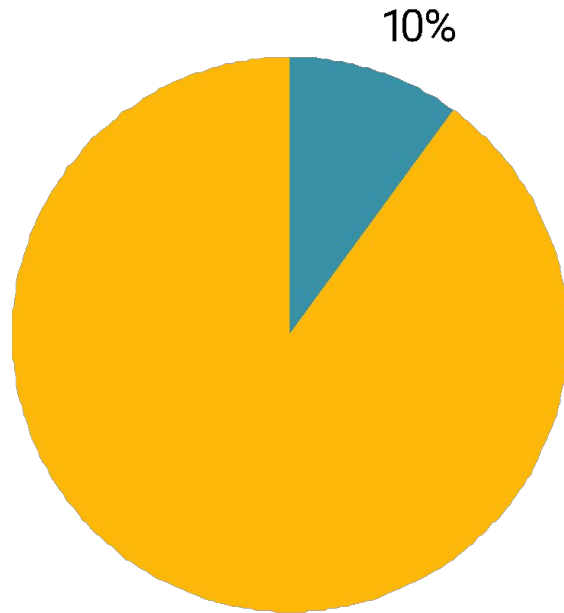


2. Do you want change something?
