# William Shakespeare (1564-1616)

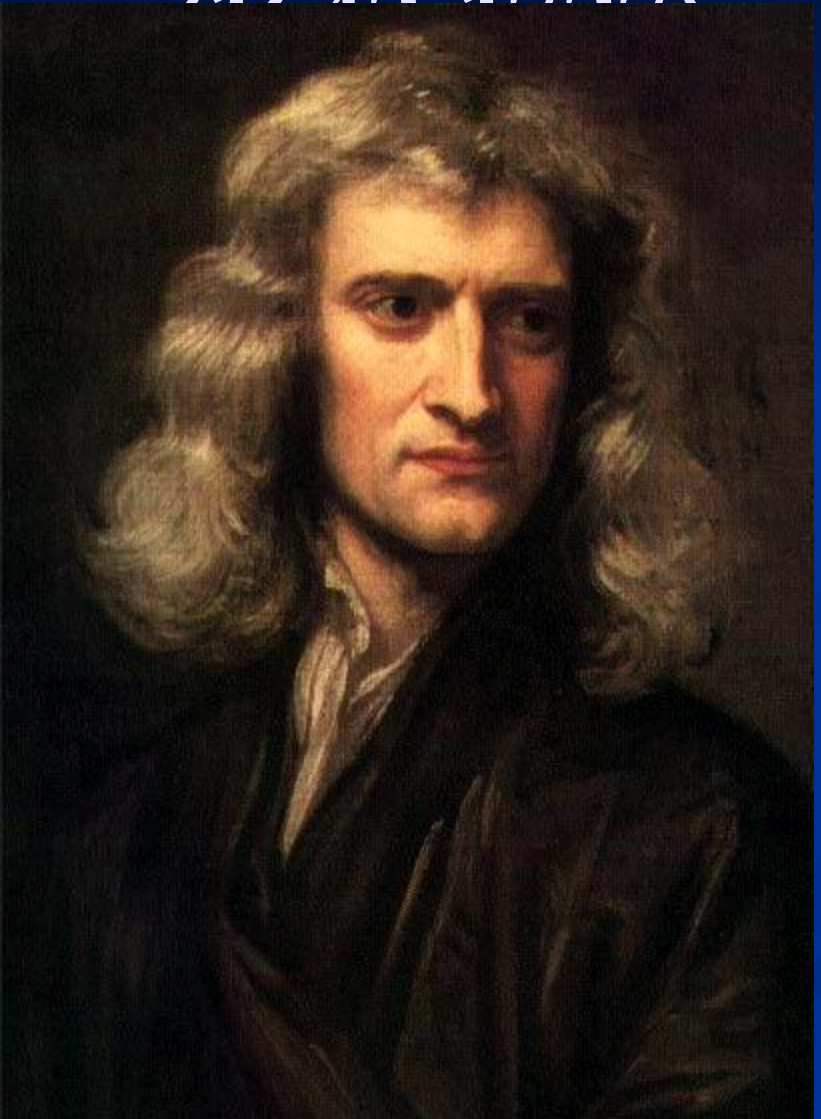
William Shakespeare was an English poet and playwright, widely regarded as the greatest writer in the English language. He is often called England's national poet and the "Bard of Avon".

A mathematician and physicist, and one of the foremost scientific intellects of all time.

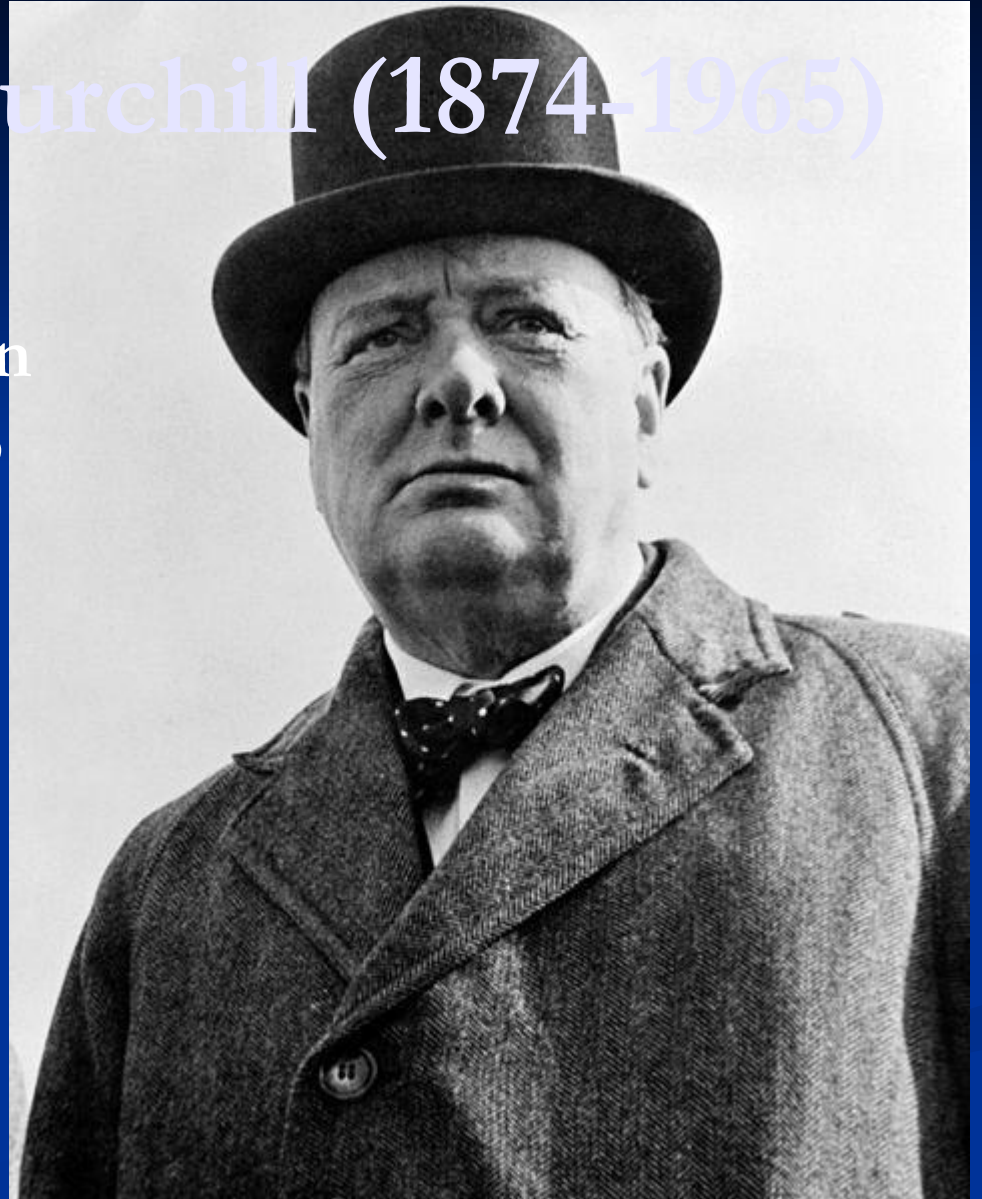
Came up with the theory of gravity.

# Queen Elizabeth II (1926-)

# Margaret Thatcher (1925-)

■ is a British politician, the longest-serving Prime Minister of the United Kingdom of the 20th century, and the only woman ever to have held the post. A Soviet journalist nicknamed her the "Iron Lady", which became associated with her uncompromising politics and leadership style.
