# Salary

- the average salary of physicians - 26 thousand rubles, about \$ 800
- the minimum salary in Russia now amounts to 13,2 thousand rubles.



- 600000 doctors are working in Russia, however doctors are not enough, because interns are leaving medical sphere.
- Private medicine is not spreading now, because this medicine is very expensive.

- Emergency ambulance service

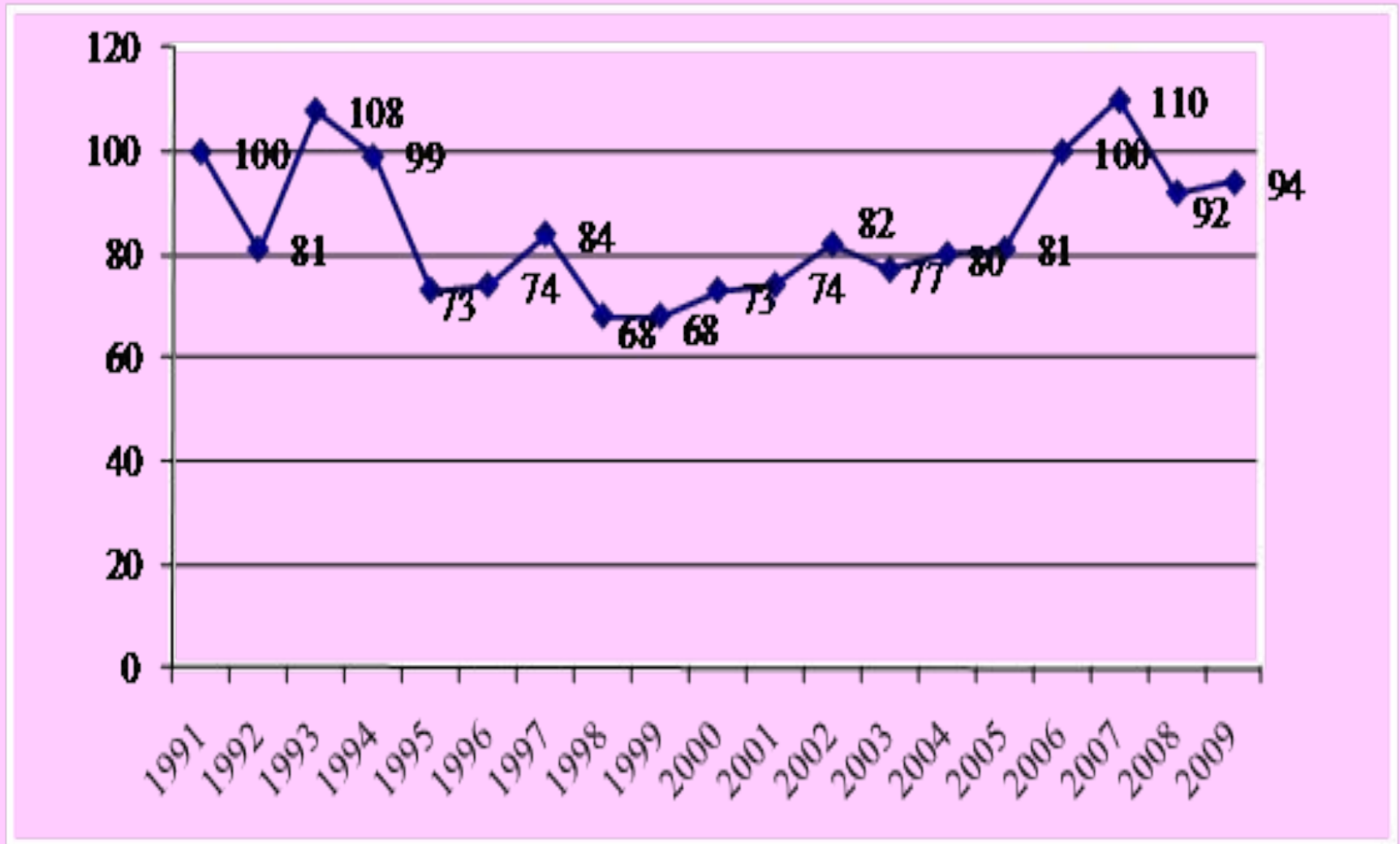


- In Russia paid and free service is appearing.
