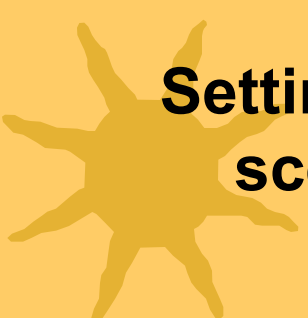

First you have to...

- ★ Decide on the type of a story: a comedy, an adventure, a fairy tale, etc
- ★ Use appropriate tenses





First you have to.....

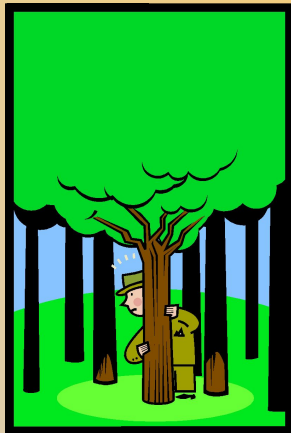
- ★ Decide who the characters are.
- ★ Who is going to be in the story?
- ★ What sort of characters are they?





Next consider

- ★ Where and when your story is going to take place.
- ★ This is called the setting.

Present ?

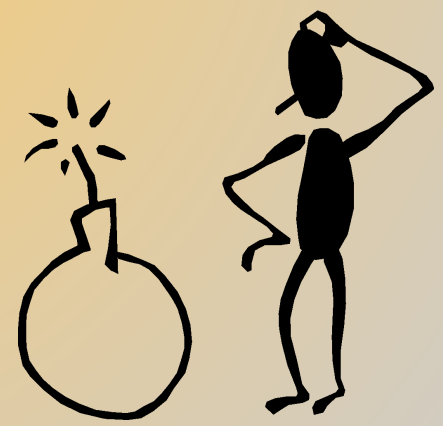

Time for the Problem....



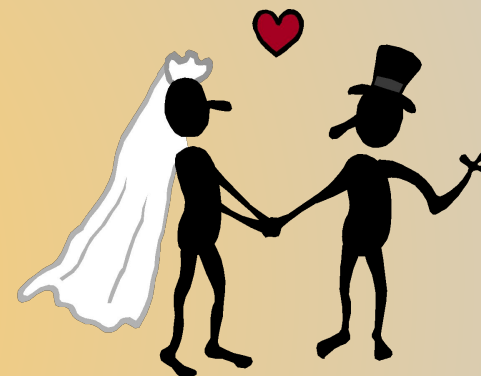
- ★ What is going to happen in your story?

Include Important Events

- ★ A summary of what happens in the story.
- ★ The events in the story
- ★ This is known as the plot.

- ★ The problem is solved.
- ★ What type of ending?
