John Lennon (1940-1980) was the founder of *The Beatles* (1960), but in 1969, he married the artist Yoko Ono, and together they made an album that generated much controversy because it showed two naked on the CD. John Lennon was killed in 1980 by a fanatic fan in front of his house with a shot.

Nothing to kill or die for

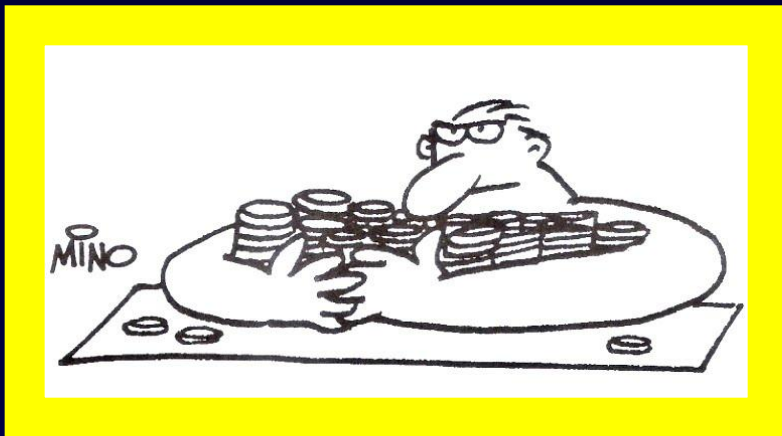
And no religion too

We use WILL to indicate that something should happen in the future, but is not in our plans.

Interrogative form:

Will the world live as one?

Affirmative form:

The world **will** live as one.

Negative form:

The world **will not** live as one.
