- •2 In three years' time I'll be writing my novel.
- 3 In four years' time I'll have written my novel.






## FUTURE CONTINUOUS

- •FORM: WILL BE + VERB + -ING
- •USE: To say that an action will be **in progress** at a certain time in the future.
- Examples:
  - •This time tomorrow, I'll be lying on the beach in the sun.
  - •Don't phone me between 7 and 8 as we'll be having dinner then.
  - •What will you be doing tomorrow at 12? (polite)



## FUTURE CONTINUOUS



- The future continuous can also be used as an alternative to the present continuous to talk about things which are already planned or decided.
- E.g.: I'll be going to the gym tomorrow afternoon.



## FUTURE CONTINUOUS EXERCISES

## FUTURE PERFECT

#### **FORM:** WILL HAVE + PAST PARTICIPLE

# **USE:** To say that something **will be finished** before a particular time in the future.

#### Typical time expressions used :

IN three weeks' / two years' / 10 hours' time / ...BY Saturday / BY next year / BY the time you arrive / ...



## FUTURE PERFECT

### **Examples:**

- •By this time next month I'll have done all the work (i.e. the work will be finished next month at the latest).
- •In 5 years' time I 'll have had two children.
- •By the time we get to the cinema, the film will have started.



## FUTURE PERFECT EXERCISES
