- Short Vowels: [i], [e], [æ], [ʊ], [ɒ], [ə], [ʌ]
- Long Vowels: [i:], [u:], [o:], [a:], [a:r]
- Diphthongs: [ei], [ai], [ɔi], [au], [əʊ], [iər], [eər], [ʊər].

[æ]

A black cat sat on a mat and ate a fat rat.

[a:]

It's hard to park such a big car in the dark.

[3:r]

The early bird catches the worm.

Consonants

- Sounds very similar to Russian ones: b, p, g, k, z, s, f, v.
- Sounds similar to Russian ones: d, t, l, n.
- Sounds different to Russian ones : r, j, t∫, dʒ, ∫, ʒ, h.
- Do not exist in Russian: w, θ, δ, η

[p], [k]
