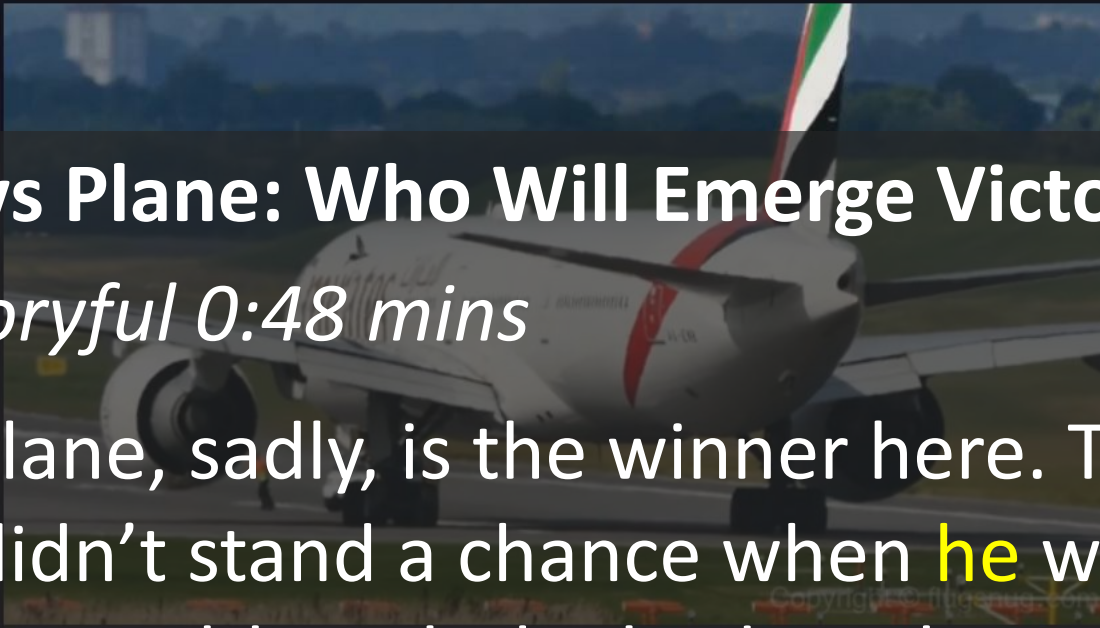

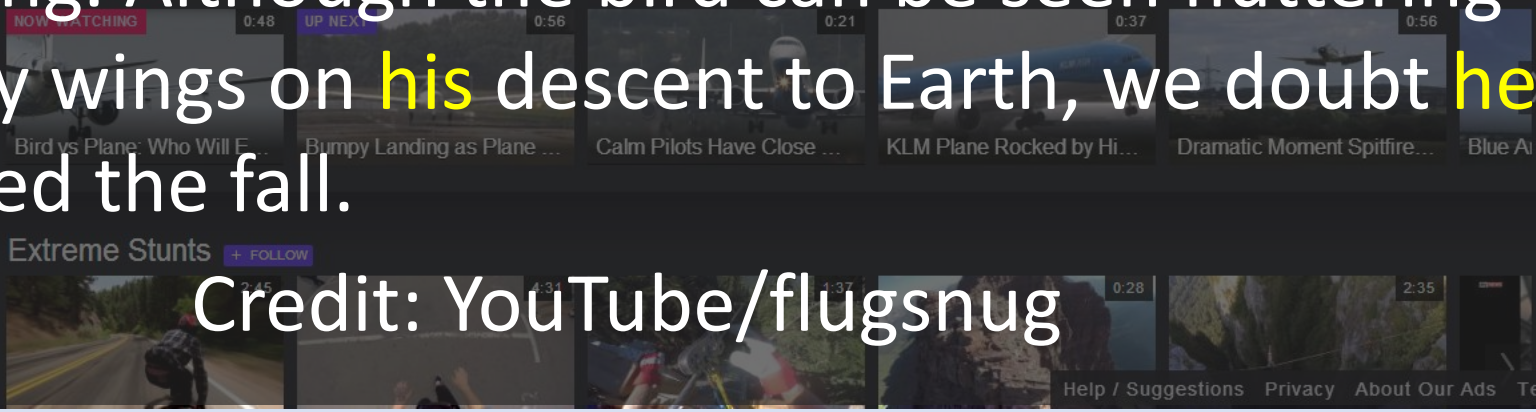

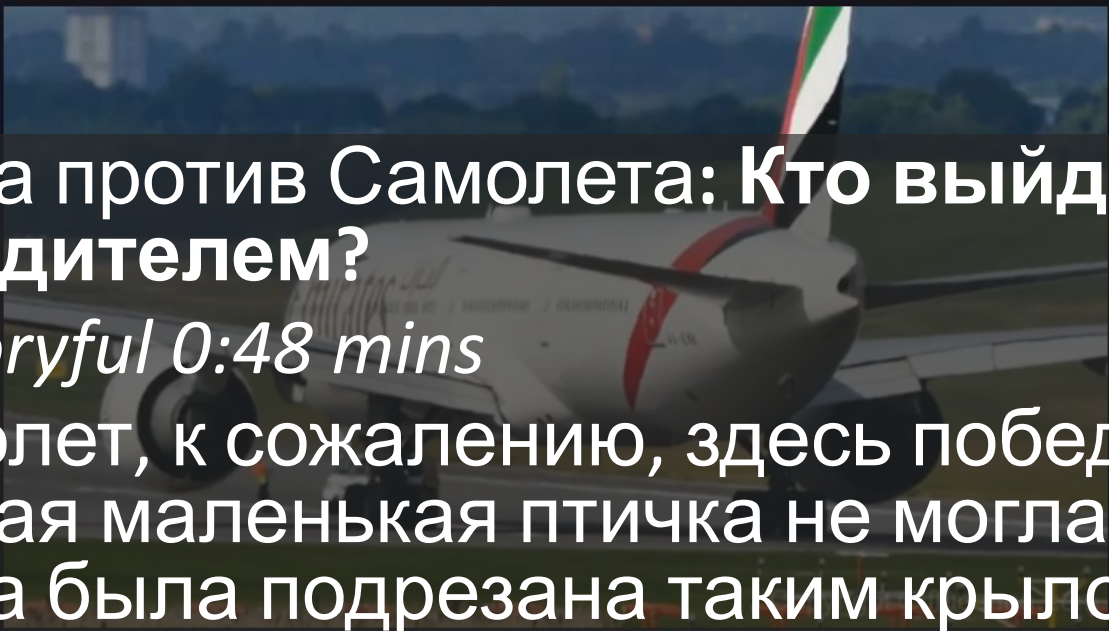

### *Watch films*

Watch movies in English and pay attention to new vocabulary and pronunciation. Imitate the actors and have fun with it.

### *Make friends*

Make friends with English speakers or others learning to speak English and compare notes. Talk about things that you have learnt and exchange ideas.

### *Do interesting activities in English*

Take a cooking course in English or join a book club! Anything you enjoy doing, make sure you do it and communicate it in English. Using English to talk about things you enjoy will make practising a positive experience.

### *Have a debate*

Debate all the topics that interest you with friends in English. Try to use as much vocabulary as you can to get your point across and listen to the other arguments carefully so you can argue against them effectively.

### *Use a dictionary*

Online dictionaries often have audio examples so you can check your pronunciation and there are lots of great dictionary apps that you can take everywhere with you on your smartphone. Make sure not to become too reliant on these tools, though. Have a go at saying the words first then check afterwards to see if you were right!

# Practice English with Mike

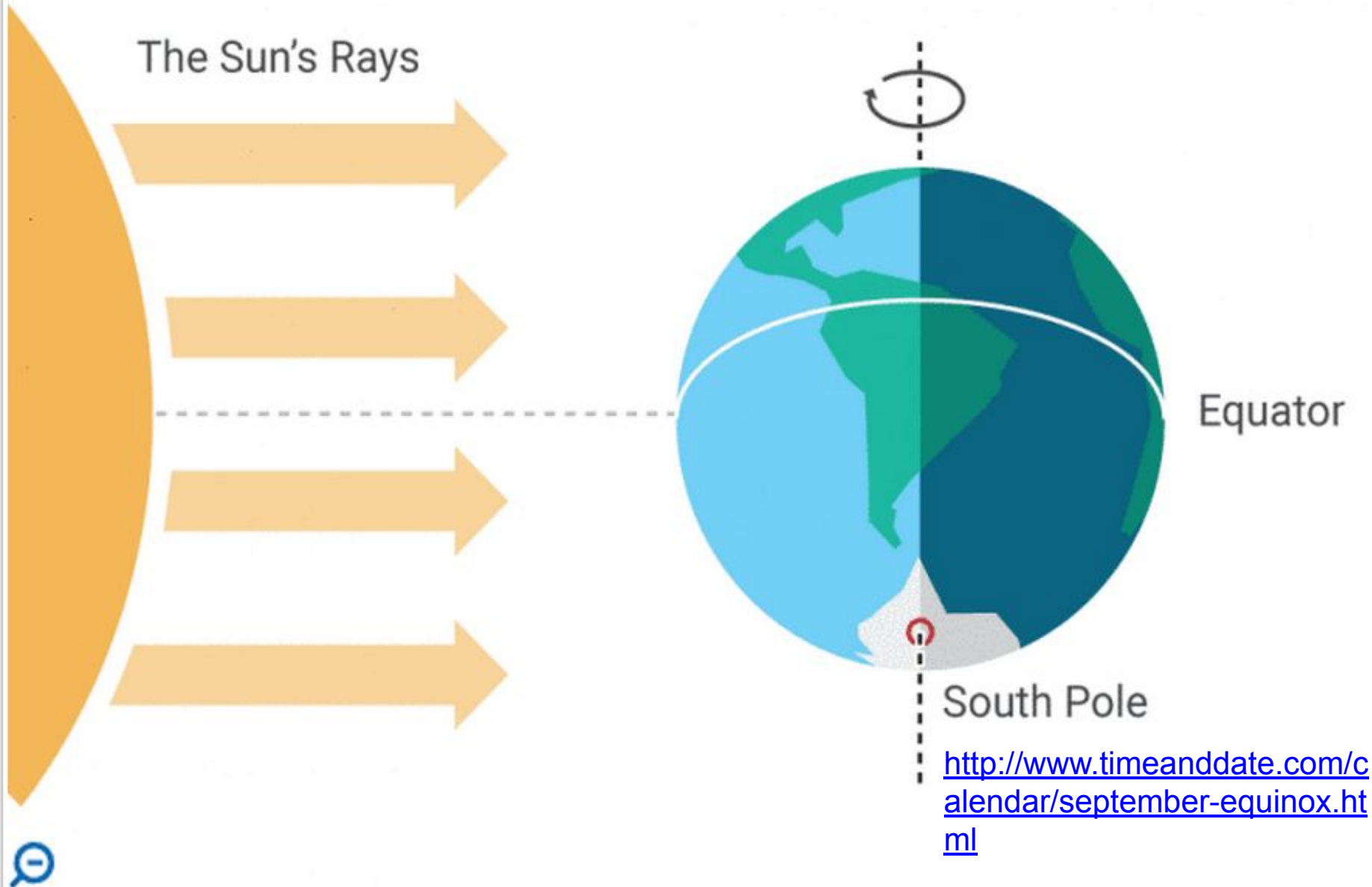
Mike is very smart. You can ask him any questions. When you want to practice the conversations of the topic you are studying at [www.eslfast.com/robot/](http://www.eslfast.com/robot/), type in "Let's practice topic ..." or "I'd like to practice topic ..." You must type the exact name of the topic. e.g. **Let's practice topic Weather (2)**. When you are acting as **A** and Robot Mike is **B**, you must type in the exact sentence in the conversation, including the punctuation. If you make a mistake, it is not controlled practice of the conversation anymore. In that case, you need to type "Let's practice topic ..." again to get the robot back on track.

# What we can tell about it

- The September equinox occurs the moment the Sun crosses the celestial equator – the imaginary line in the sky above the Earth's equator – from north to south. This happens either on September 22, 23, or 24 every year.
- On the equinox, night and day are nearly exactly the same length – 12 hours – all over the world. This is the reason it's called an "equinox", derived from Latin, meaning "equal night". However, even if this is widely accepted, it isn't entirely true. In reality equinoxes don't have exactly 12 hours of daylight.

# What we can tell about it

Television advertisement or TV commercial is called commercial or TV ad in US, advert in UK and TVC by industry insiders. ## Hallelujah, I Love Her So

Материал из Википедии — свободной энциклопедии

**«Hallelujah, I Love Her So»** («Аллилуйя, я так люблю её») — песня в стиле ритм-н-блюз, написанная и впервые исполненная американским музыкантом Рэем Чарльзом. Песня была опубликована в 1956 году в виде сингла (с песней «What Would I Do Without You» на стороне «Б»); позднее она вошла в альбом *Ray Charles* (1957 год). Песня достигла пятой позиции в чарте *Rhythm & Blues Records*. Так же как и более ранние песни Рэя Чарльза «*I Got a Woman*» и «*This Little Girl of Mine*», данная песня в качестве истоков использовала стиль *госпел*, однако характеризуется вполне светским текстом. Песня значительно способствовала популярности Рэя Чарльза, стала весьма известной и впоследствии перепевалась многими знаменитыми исполнителями.

«Hallelujah, I Love Her So» представляет собой своего рода гимн радостным проявлениям любви (в оригинальной версии по ходу развития сюжета оказывается, что речь идёт о любви отца к дочери: «She kisses me and she hold me tight, and tell me „Daddy everything’s all right“» — «Она целует и крепко обнимает меня, и говорит: „Папа, всё хорошо“»). Характерными чертами музыкального оформления являются необычное звучание духовых инструментов и запоминающееся *саксофонное* соло. Продюсером песни выступил Джерри Уэкслер.
