Charlotte Bronte was born on April 21st 1816 at Thornton, Bradford in Yorkshire, third child of the six Bronte children.



• The major event of her childhood is when her mother, Maria Branwell, died.

Conditions there were very bad even by standarts of the time, and it was not long before both Maria and Elizabeth became ill enough to be sent home, where they both died of consumption in the spring of 1825. • In 1824 she attended the newly opened Clergy Daughters' School at Cowan Bridge. In June 1825 Charlotte and her sisters were finally taken away from the school for good.
