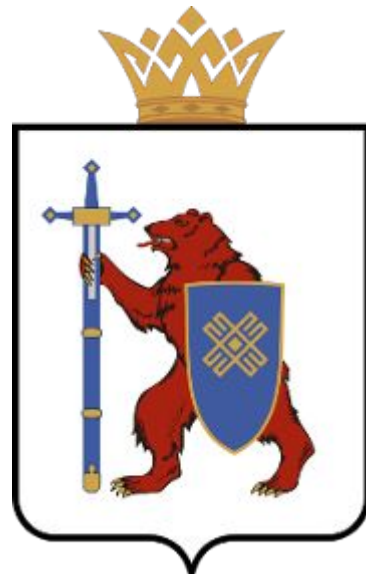

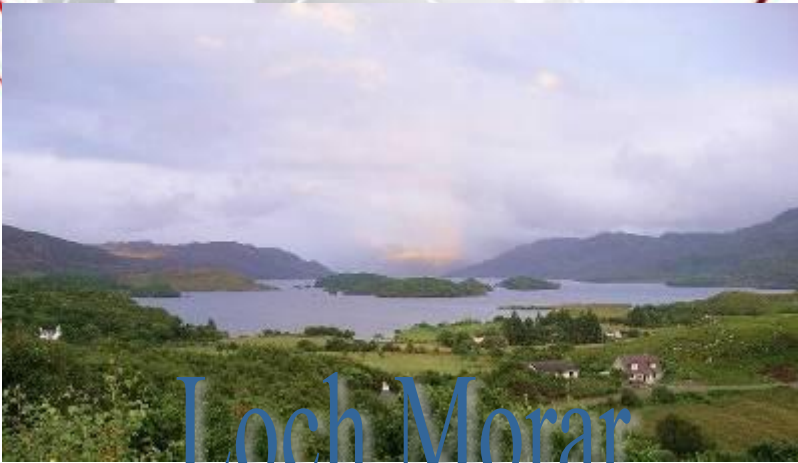

- Scotland & England united in 1707

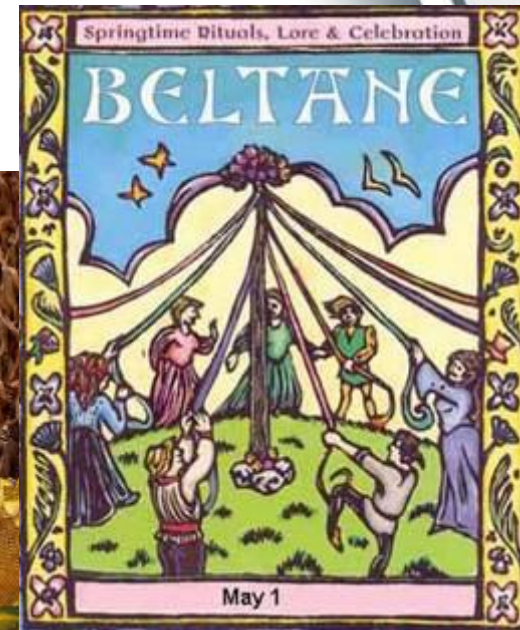
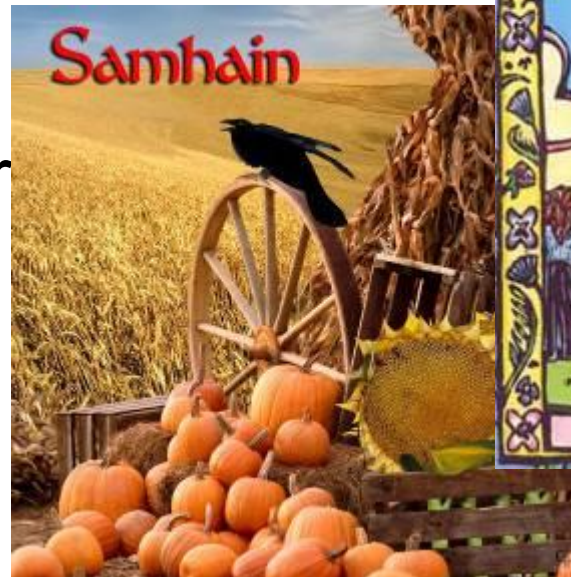


- 1440s – was incorporated into the Khanate of Kazan

Scottish Celebrations

- Samhain /'sɑ:wɪn/
 - a Gaelic festival marking the end of the harvest season and the beginning of winter or the "darker half" of the year.
 - It is celebrated from sunset on 31 October to sunset on 1 November
- Beltane or Beltain /'bɛlteɪn/
 - 30 April–1 May
 - It marked the beginning of summer



Mari Celebrations

- Shyzhe Pazar (Шыже Пазар)
- To mark the end of the harvest season
- 21 November
- Agavairem (Агавайрем)
- To mark the end of the spring work in the field
- 5 June
