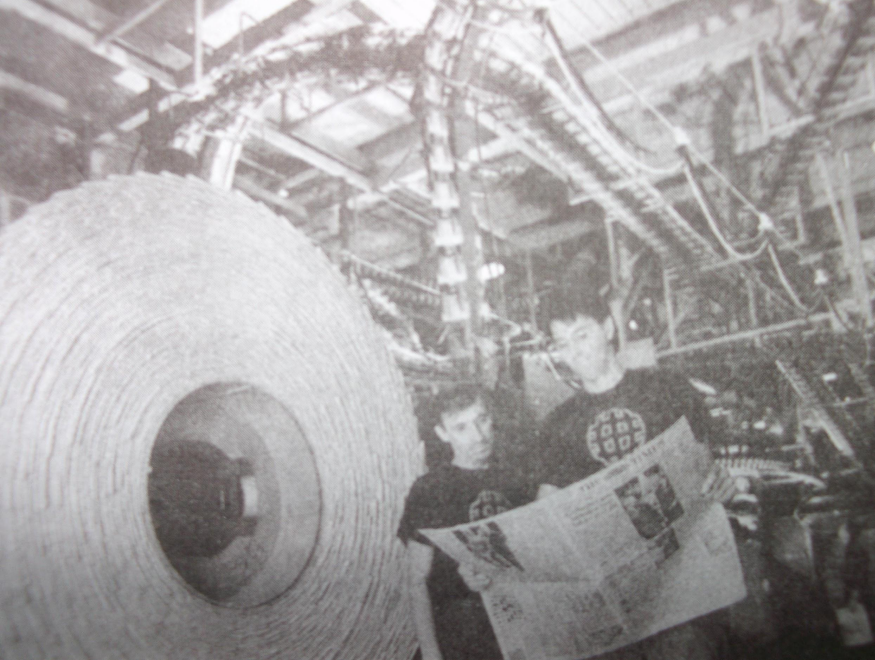

## OFFICIALS CONFIRM FIRST LOCAL CASE OF SWINE FLU!

Officials in the region of St. Lucia have already confirmed over 20 cases of swine flu. Jamaica and Barbados have 19 and 18 reported cases, respectively, according to the World Health Organization, which is warning of a possible pandemic. The region's health authorities have reported a total of 20 confirmed cases.

On Monday an early morning press announcement by the chief medical officer, Dr. George A. Williams, confirmed the first case of swine flu in St. Lucia was the 19th entry in the world to confirm the presence of the H1N1 influenza virus. The first case was reported on Monday, June 29th.

## Excitement rockets after otherworldly sighting

IT CAME from outer space, a strange object blazing across the Johannesburg sky that is what it seemed - a UFO - and with it on Sunday night came a flood of calls to observatories and Talk Radio 702.

Witnesses reported seeing a bright pulsating light with a halo and a second object that followed it.

But by yesterday, astronomers knew it had been caused by a US space rocket performing tests after it had released its satellite payload.

The object was seen over South Africa on Sunday.

"Calls just began flooding in," said Melony Spark, a student astronomer in the Western Cape.

Claire Flanagan, of the Johannesburg Planetarium, said: "One man said he was jacked-bumping and had watched the object through the scope of his rifle."

Flanagan received numerous calls not only from Joburg, but from Klerkskop, Rustenburg and the Free State too.

Spark was able to track the object's flight path. Soon it was spotted in Italy. "It took half an hour to log it across Africa," she said.

On Sunday evening, a rocket carrying a US military weather satellite blasted off from Vandenberg Air Force Base in California.

The objects that witnesses saw are believed to have been the rocket and a satellite. Once the rocket was over Europe, it dumped fuel and left Earth's orbit around Greenland.

Europeans also noticed the object and posted footage on the internet.

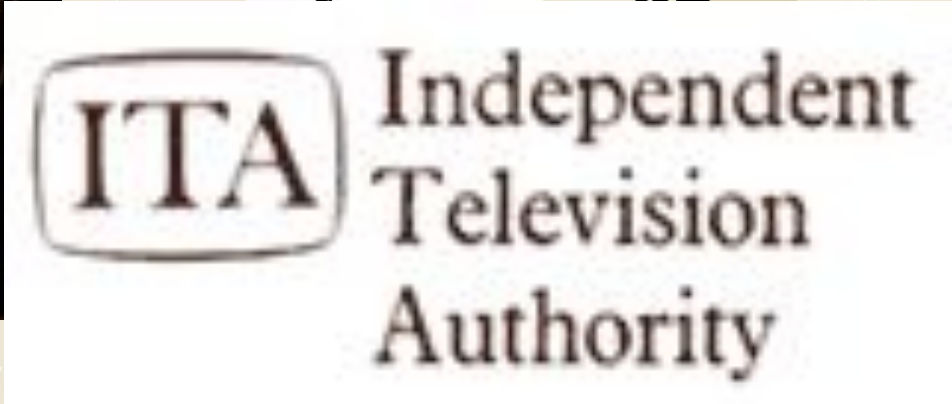

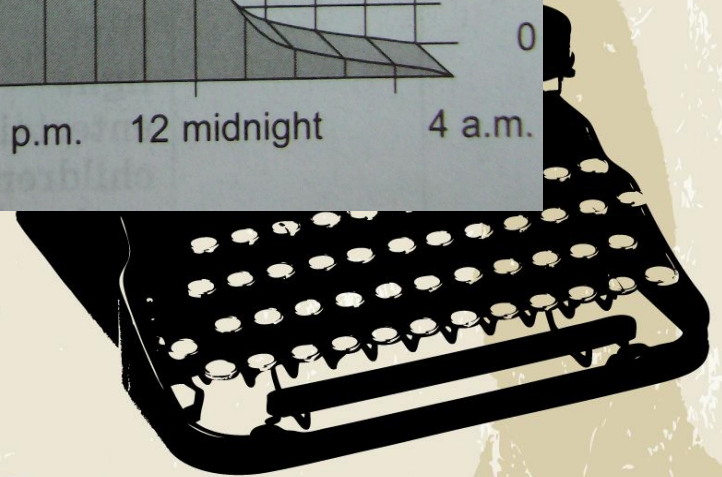
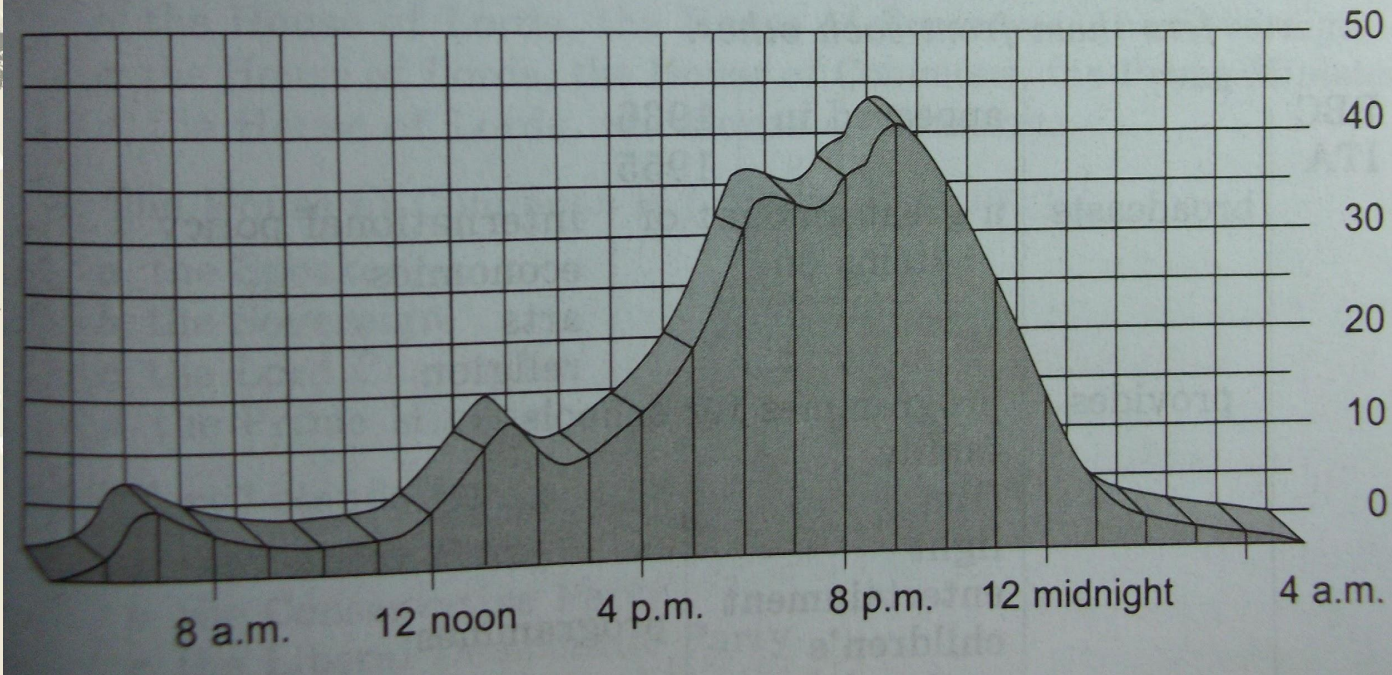
