- Administrative center of Kolomensky District
- Situated on the banks of the Moskva and the Oka rivers
- Was found in 1177
- Population is about 145,000



Shortly about history of Kolomna

- Was a protective shield for Ryazan against Crimean and Kazan Tatars
- It was first mentioned in the Russian Chronicles in 1177
