




The economy of Venezuela

- GDP for 2009 was US\$13,000
- About 30% of the population of the country live on less than US \$2 per day
- Venezuela manufactures and exports heavy industry products such as steel, aluminium and cement

 - Venezuela has a limited national railway system, which has no active rail connections to other countries

The Venezuelan Bolivar Fuerte is the currency of Venezuela.






The currency code for Bolivares
