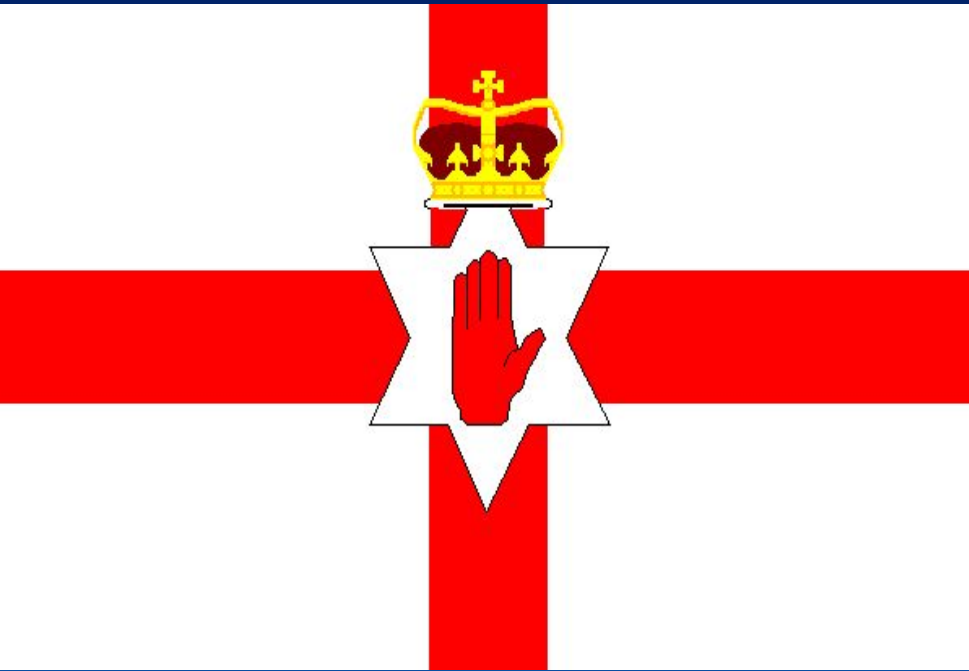

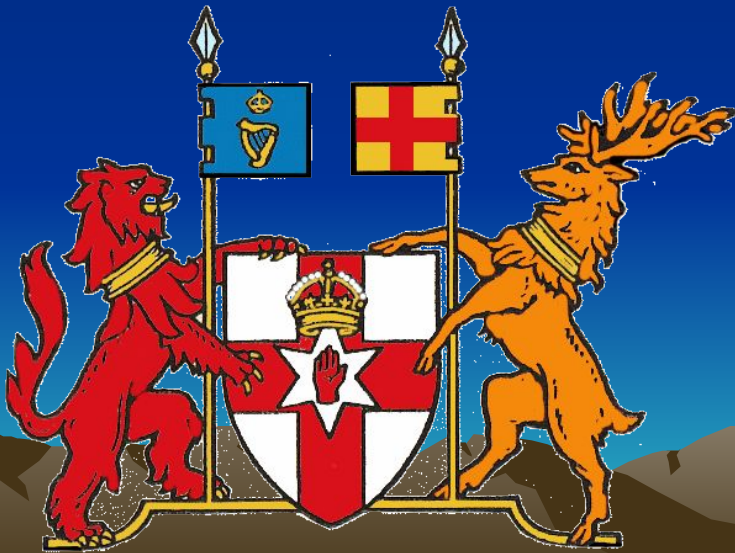


Flag of Northern Ireland.

Belfast



- is the capital and the largest city in Northern Ireland, as well as the second largest city on the island of Ireland.

- The city of Belfast has a population of 267,500
- Belfast remains a centre for industry, as well as the arts, higher education and business, a legal centre, and is the economic engine of Northern Ireland
- There were bloody years in Belfast caused by the struggle between Irish and Ulster terrorists but now the violence of former years is over.

- The **River Lagan** is a major river in Northern Ireland which runs 40 miles (60 km)



Derry

Derry or Londonderry is the second biggest city in Northern Ireland and the fourth-biggest city on the island of Ireland.

In 2013, Derry will become the first city to be designated UK City of Culture, having been awarded the title in July 2010
