Plural Nouns

Regular Plurals

end with *s* or *es*.

Add **-es to make nouns plural that **end**
with:**

- **s**
- **x**
- **ch**
- **sh**

Add **-ies** to make nouns plural that **end**
with a **consonant and -y**:

Lady

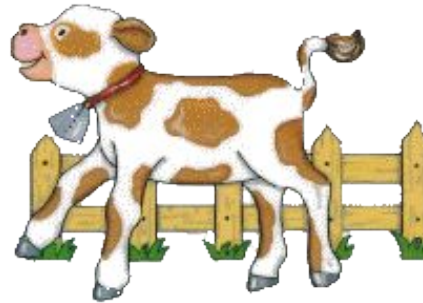

- **Knife**

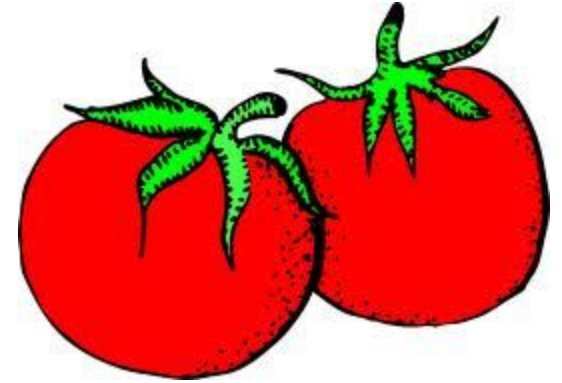

- **Sheep**



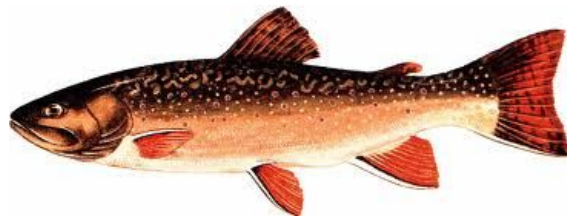
- **Deer**



- **Moose**

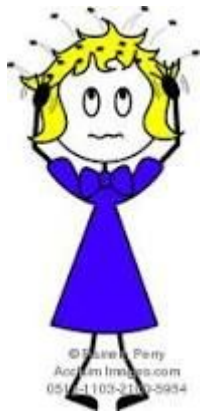
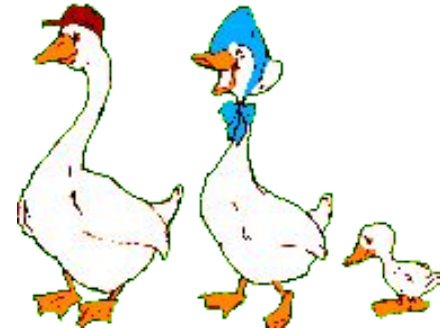

- **Louse**

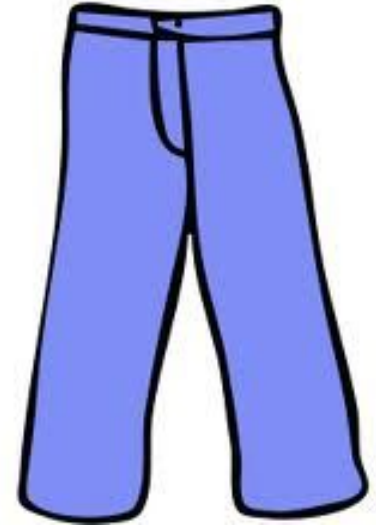
