CARDINAL AND ORDINAL NUMBERS

- Cardinal numbers are used in counting and answer the question "how many?"
 - 245
 - **7,068**
 - 5,673,000
 - 143,564,729
 - 6%
- Cardinal numbers are used to designate apartment, houses, buses, pages, chapters and routes.
 - They live in 27 Oxford street, Apartment 5.
 - I go to school on bus 44.

CARDINAL AND ORDINAL NUMBERS

- Ordinal numbers are used in indicating order and answer the question "which?"
- □ 1,2,3...
- □ 11,12,13...
- Remember the use of definite articles

USE OF COMMAS IN NUMBERS

- Commas are used when we want to express the quantity of something:
 - 3,348 people attended the seminar last week.
 - Each year the city is responsible for over 90,000 tons of waste.
 - There are over 1,200 different species of bats in the world.
- Commas are not used in numbers which identify something:
 - Don lived at 18325 Magnolia Street.
 - Please quote reference 6812-4478

USE OF A DOT OR DECIMAL POINTS

- □ In English we use dots or full stops in decimals to signify something below the denomination of 1.
 - 0.6
 - 0.25%
 - 1.95
 - \$1.99
 - 0.128
 - 0.0007

HYPHEN -

- □ A hyphen (-) is used when we spell numbers from 21 to 99 out in words.
 - Twenty-one
 - Ninety-nine
- It is also used when we spell fractions out in words.
 - Two-thirds
 - One-half
 - Three-quarters
