- Oksana Savchenko - eight-time champion of the Paralympic Games in swimming for short distances

German neurologist, who established Paralympic Games in England.

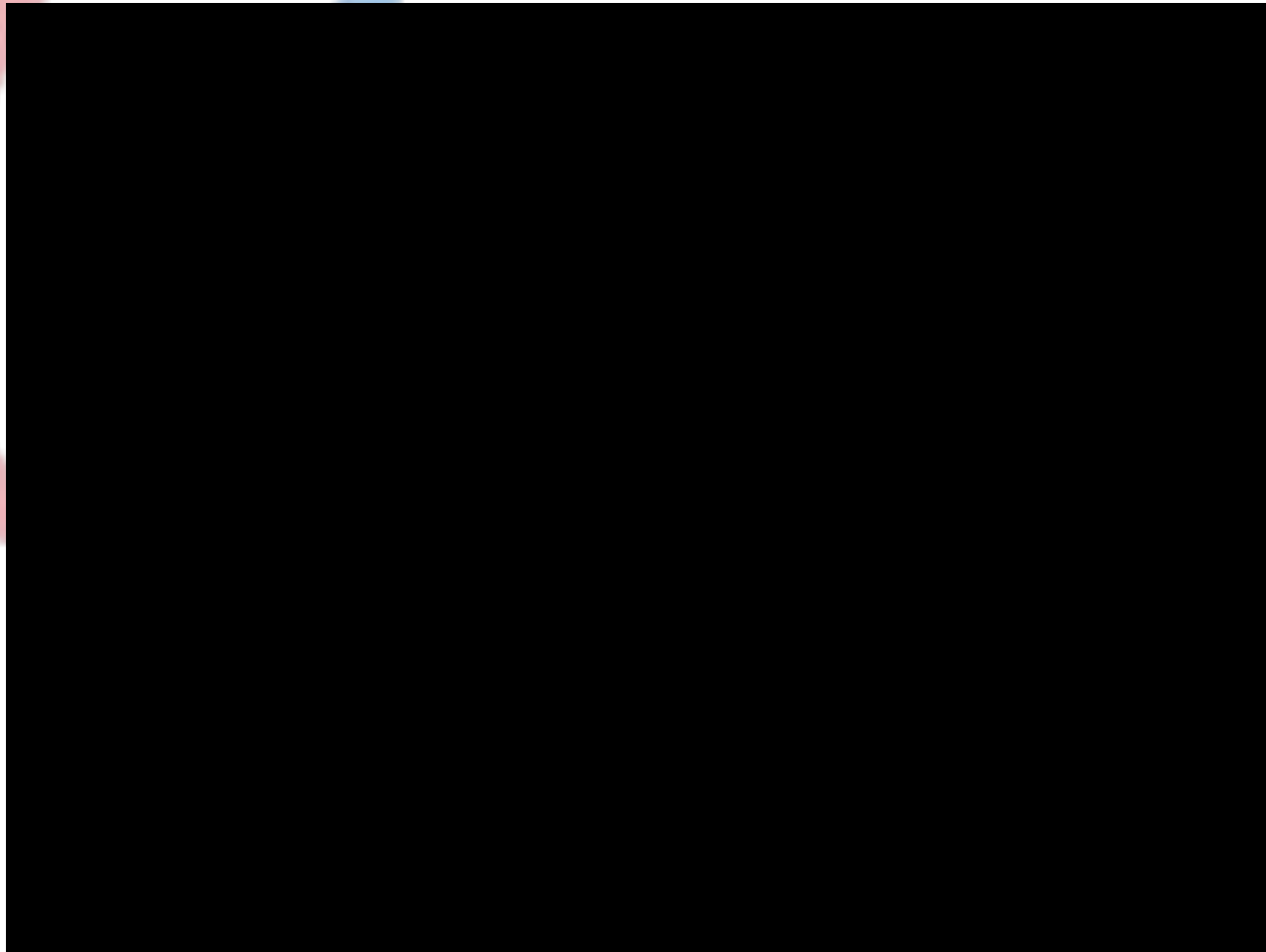
I Summer Paralympics started since 1960 in Rome. I Winter Paralympics started only in 1976 in Sweden.
