Способы образования

По способу образования глаголы делятся на две группы



Правильные (слабые)

Verb + ed

Неправильные (сильные)

Verb₂

Правильные (слабые) глаголы

Verb + ed

want – wanted

Особые случаи

1. Глаголы, оканчивающиеся на – e

dance - danced

2. Глаголы, оканчивающиеся на – *согласную* + y

cry

cried

3. Глаголы, оканчивающиеся на **закрытый слог, имеющий одну согласную на конце.**

stop

stop **p**ed

4. Глаголы, оканчивающиеся на – **l**

travel- **l**travell**e**d

Неправильные (сильные) глаголы

Имеют особые формы, которые необходимо запомнить!

Break - broke

Buy - bought

Bring - brought

Teach - taught

Let - let

Put - put

sell - sold

tell - told

hold - held

do - did

You were You were

He was

She was

They were

It was

Модальные глаголы в Прошедшем времени

Can

could

May

might

Should

should

Must

Формы прошедшего времени
не имеет!

have to

had to

Вынужден, поневоле обязан

Постановка вопросов (слабые глаголы)

They **played** football yesterday.

Did they **play ed** football yesterday?

Постановка вопросов (сильные глаголы)

She **came** home late yesterday.

Did she **come** home late yesterday ?

Отрицания с Past Indefinite

She **came** home late yesterday.

She **didn't** ~~come~~ home late yesterday.

We **were** in Moscow last week.

We **were** i **not** scow last week

Перестройте предложения в Past Indefinite

Susan reads much every day.

Susan reads much last week .

The girls often come here.

The girls often came here.

Max visits us very often this year.

Max visited us very often last year.

Mother brings fruit every week.

Mother brought fruit yesterday.

Отрицания с Past Indefinite

Lena **wrote** the letter to her friend.

Lena **didn't write** the letter to her friend.

He **was** at home yesterday.

He **was not** home yesterday.

They **stood** at the lesson.

They **didn't stand** at the lesson.

John and David **were** at the stadium.

John and David **weren't** at the stadium.

The boys **had** a new ball.

The boys **didn't have** a new ball.
