% of the district total

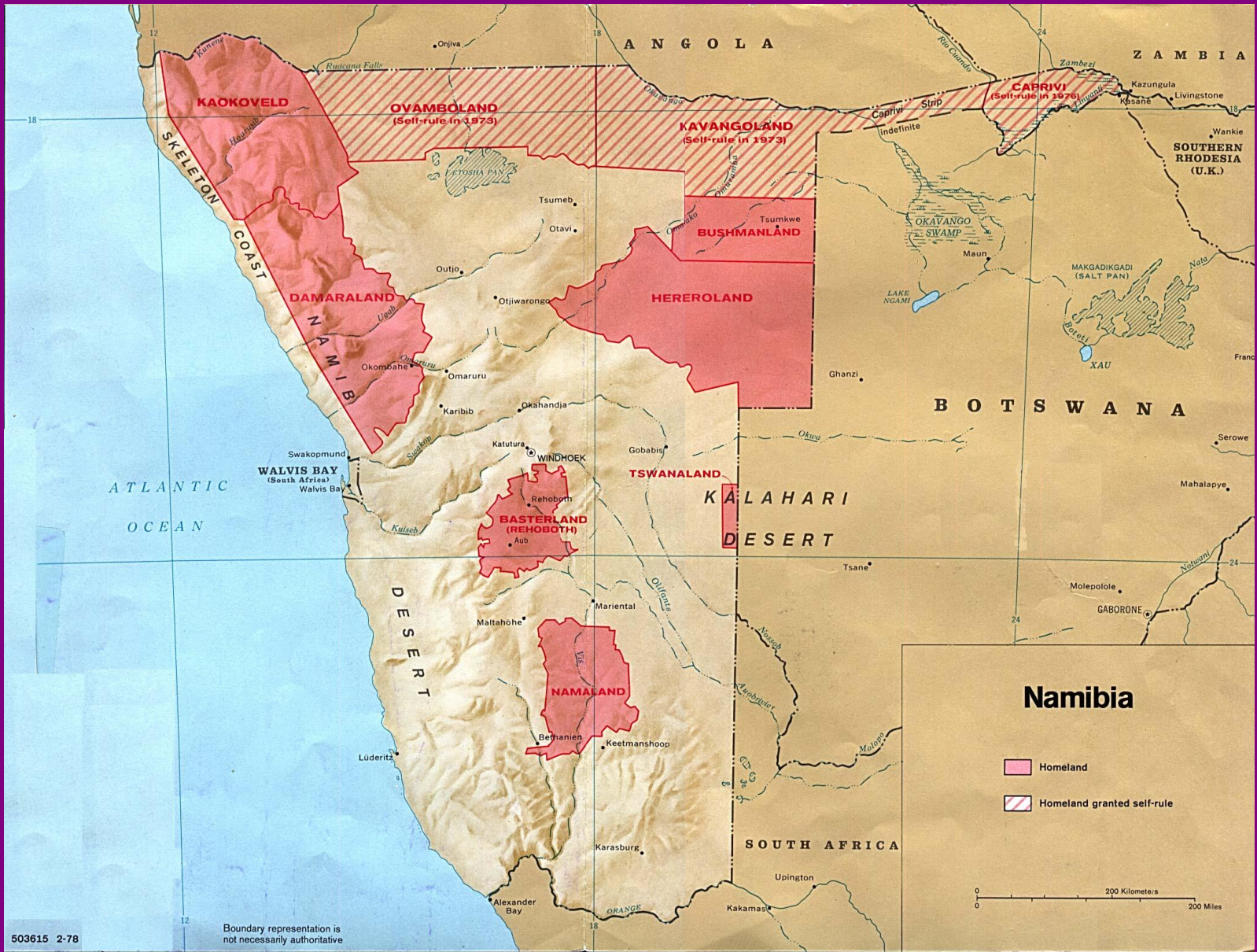

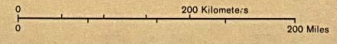


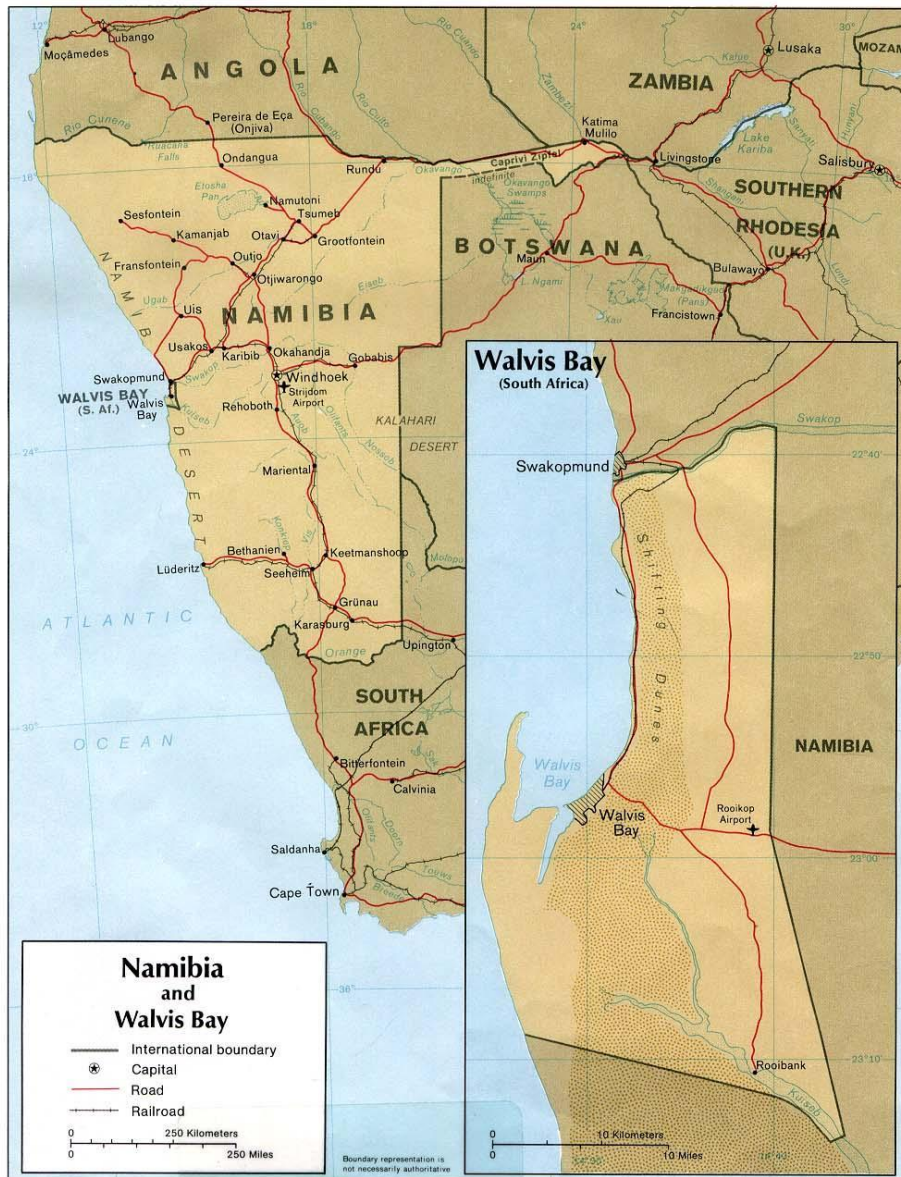
