## South America 1780

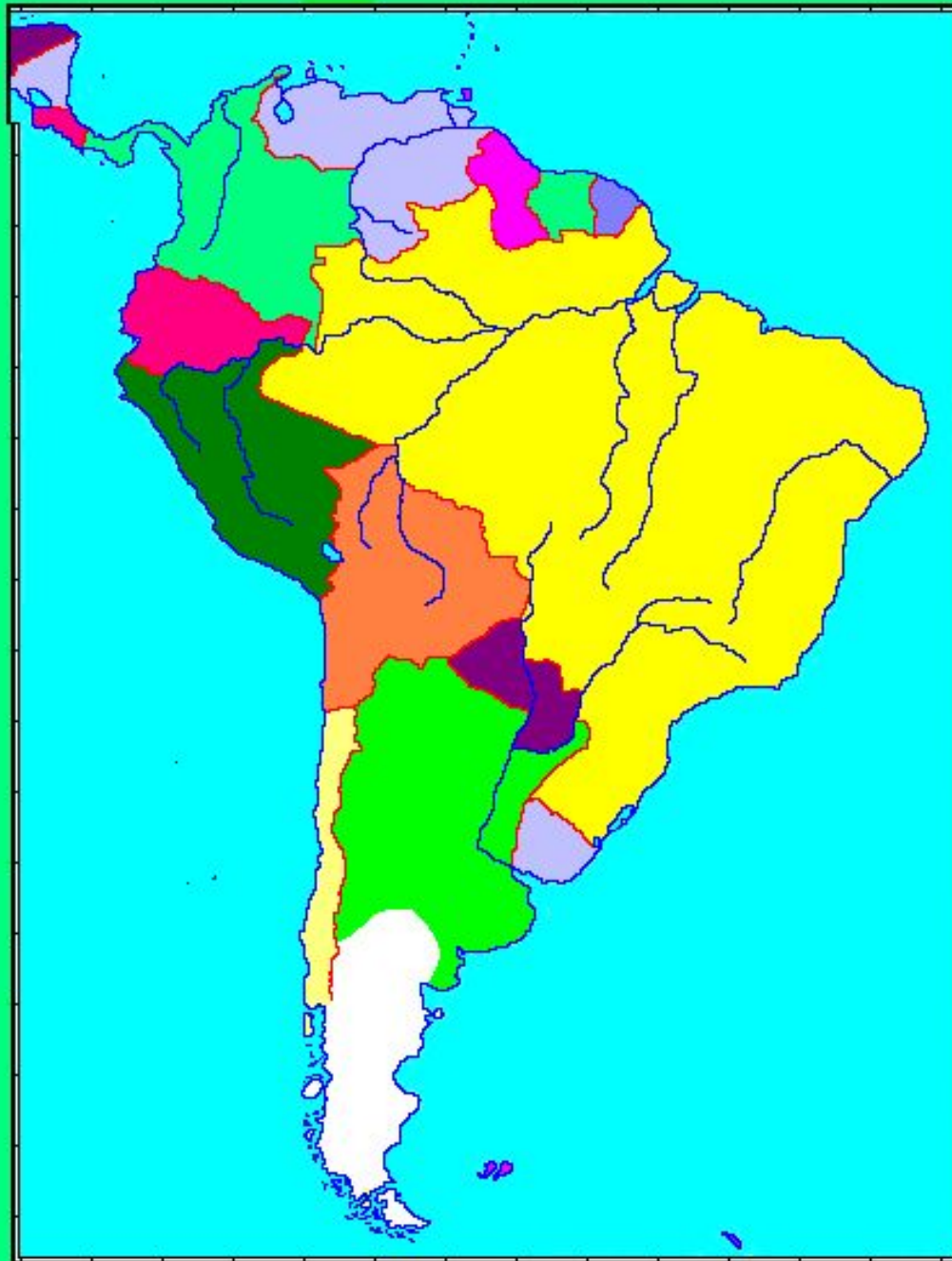

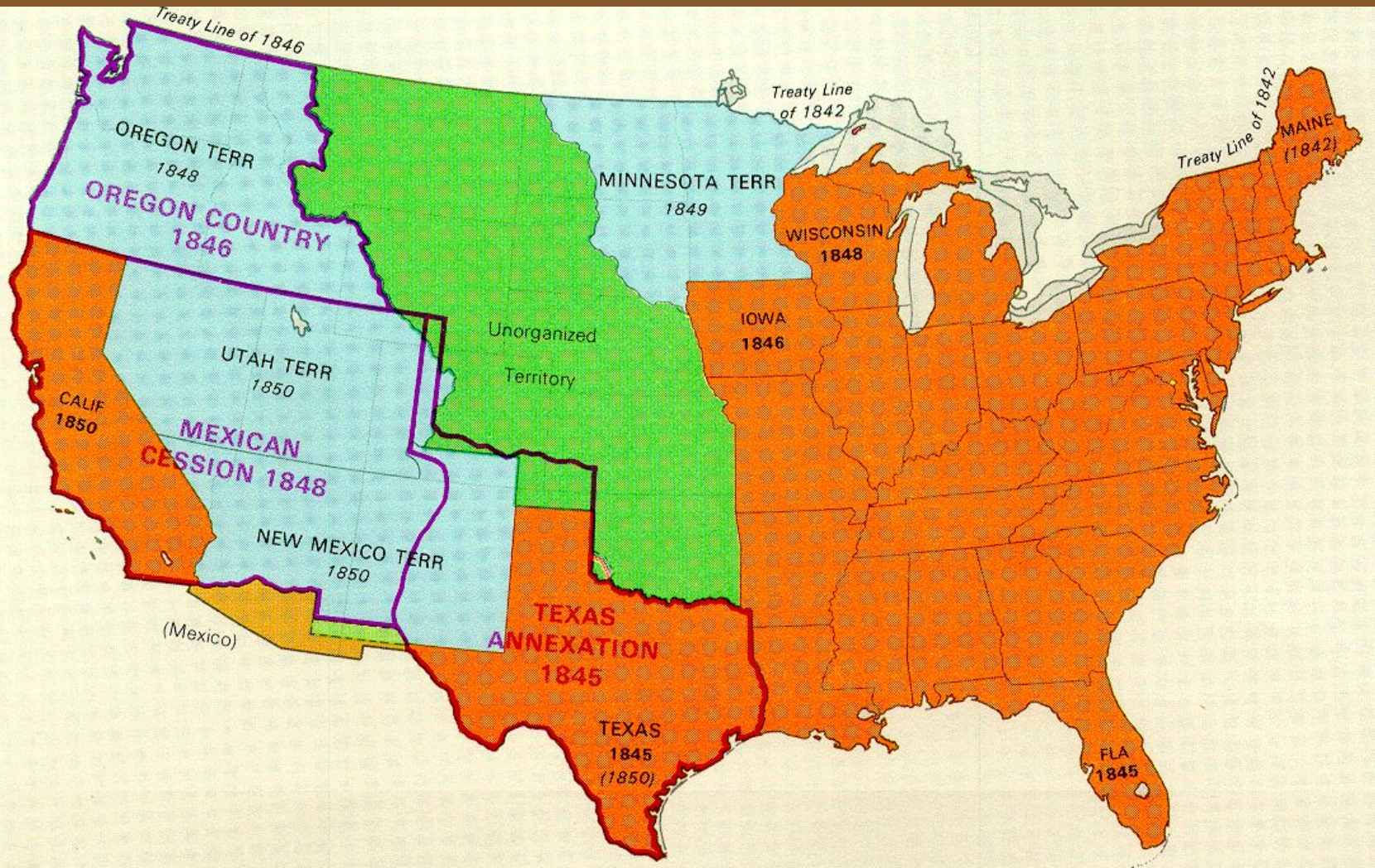

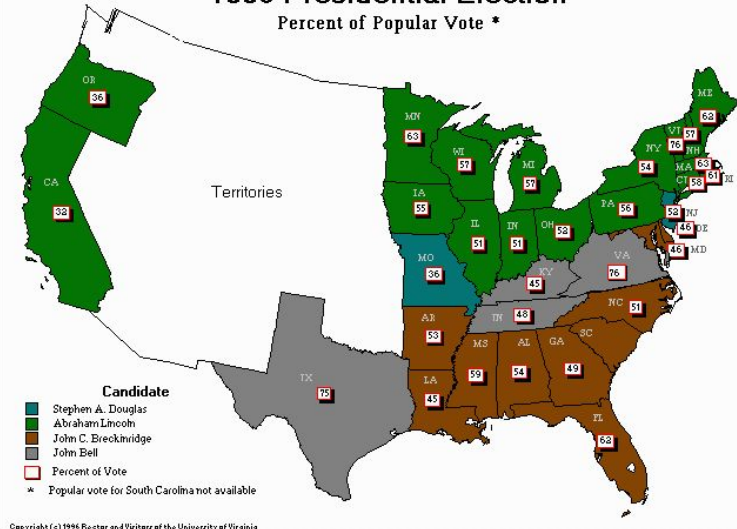

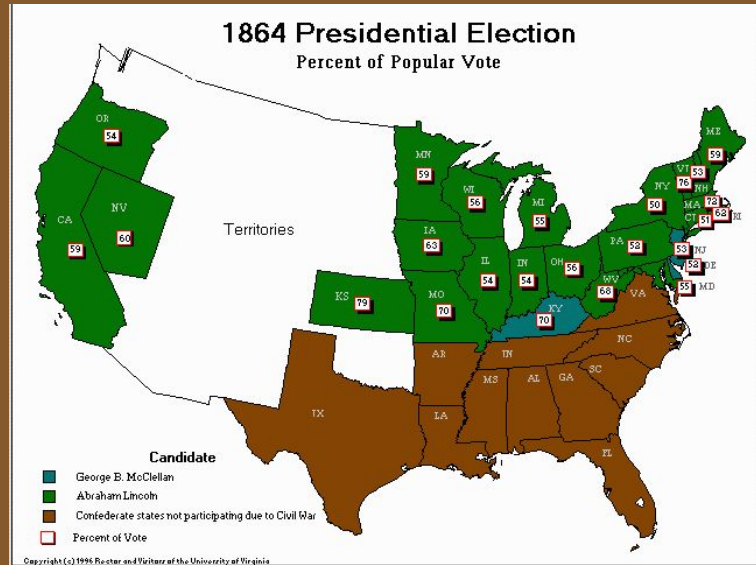
### 1860 Presidential Election

Percent of Popular Vote \*



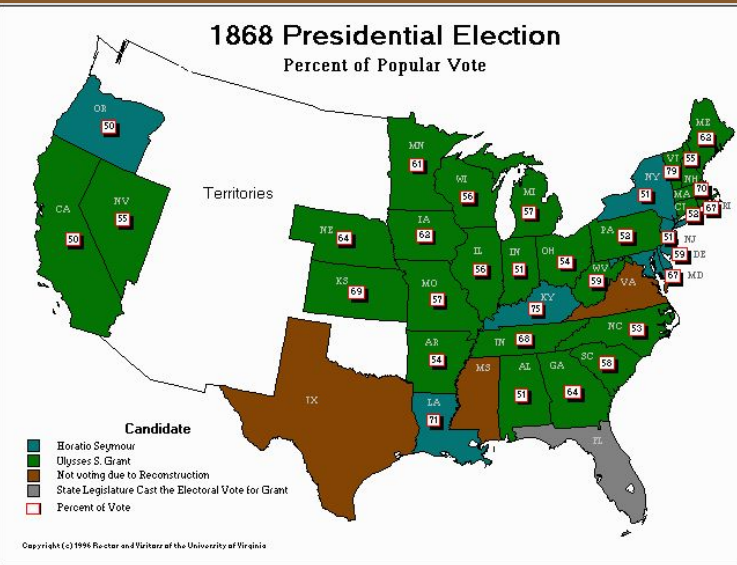
### 1864 Presidential Election

Percent of Popular Vote



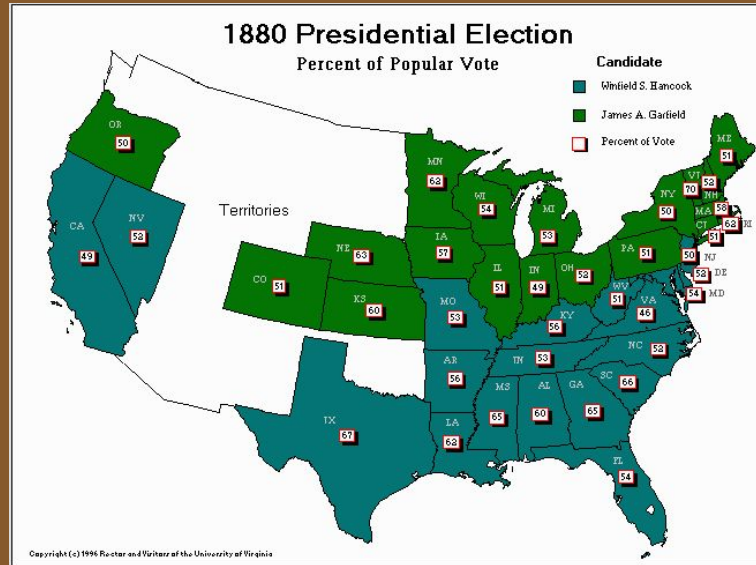

Percent of Popular Vote

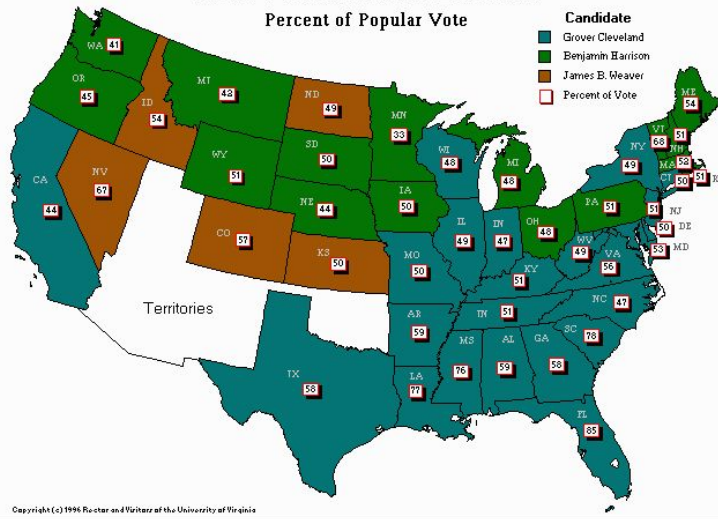

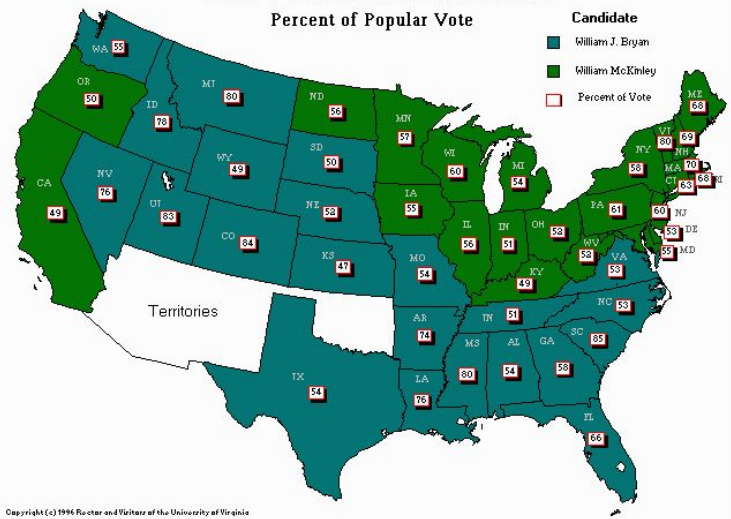

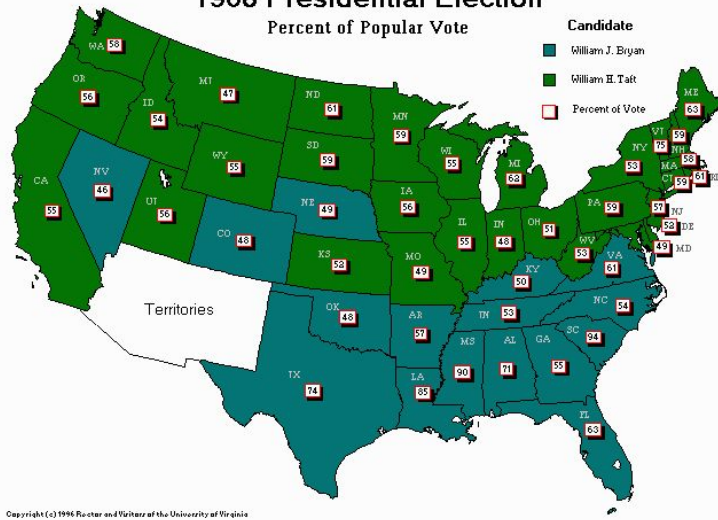
### 1892 Presidential Election Percent of Popular Vote



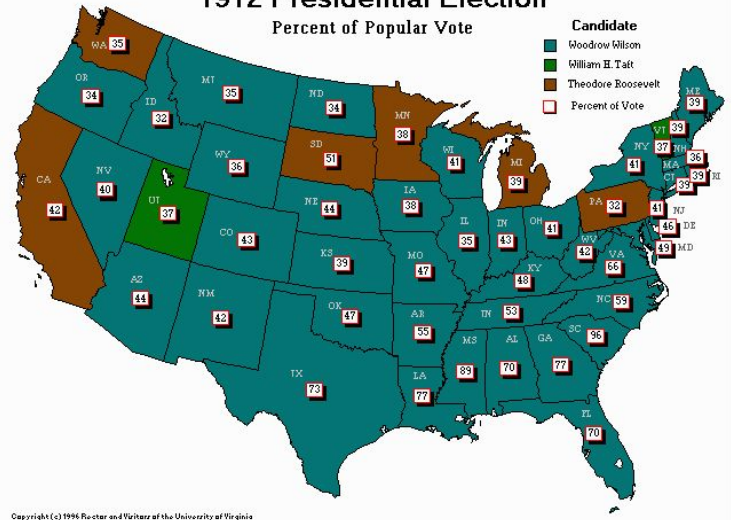
### 1896 Presidential Election Percent of Popular Vote



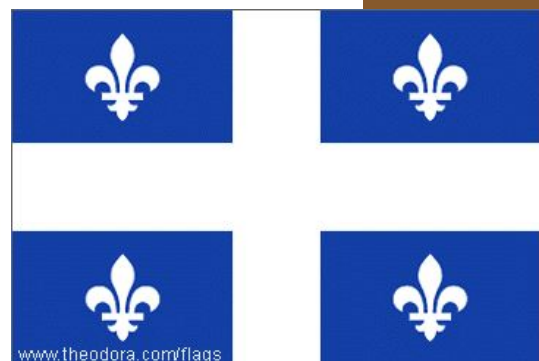
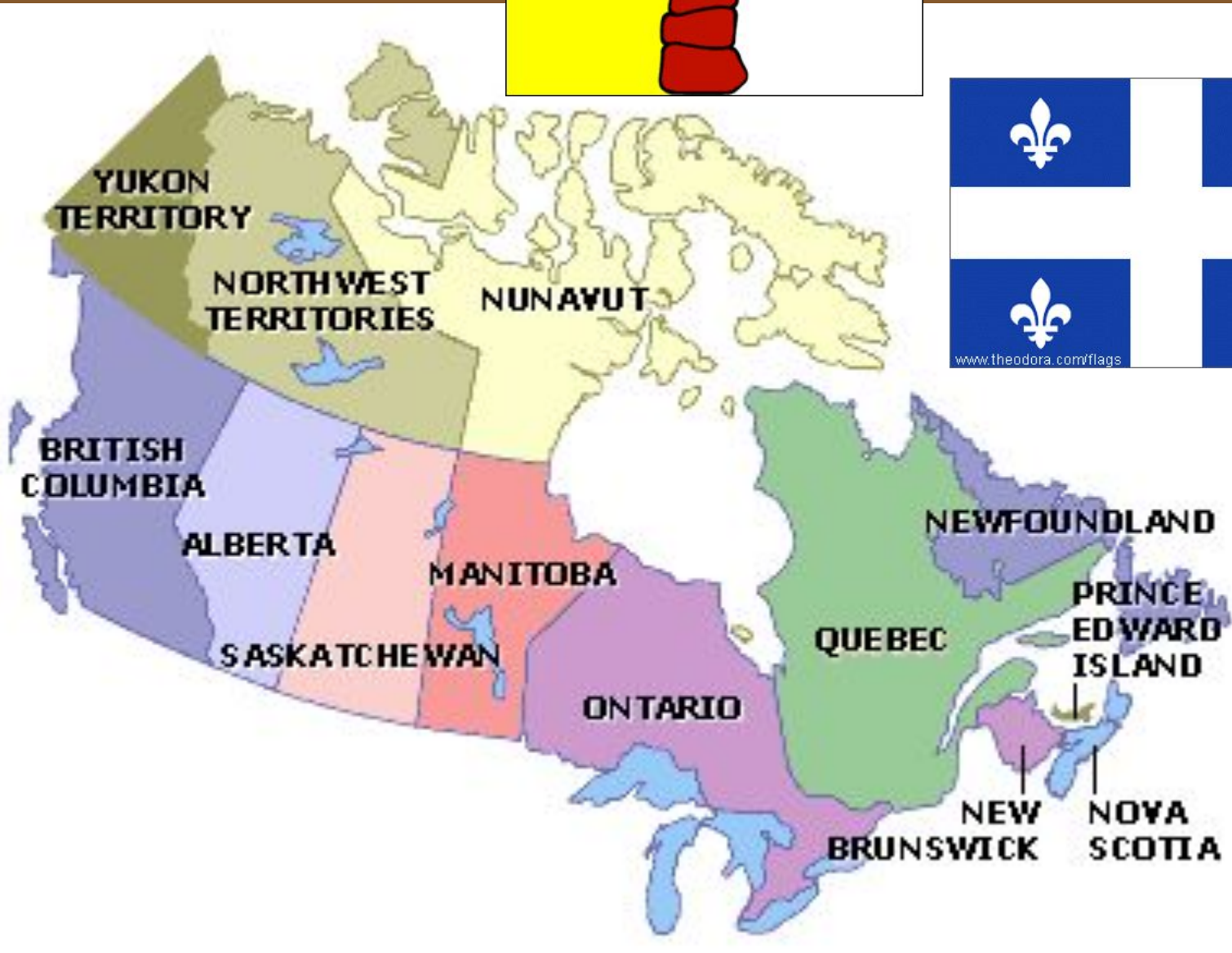
### 1908 Presidential Election Percent of Popular Vote



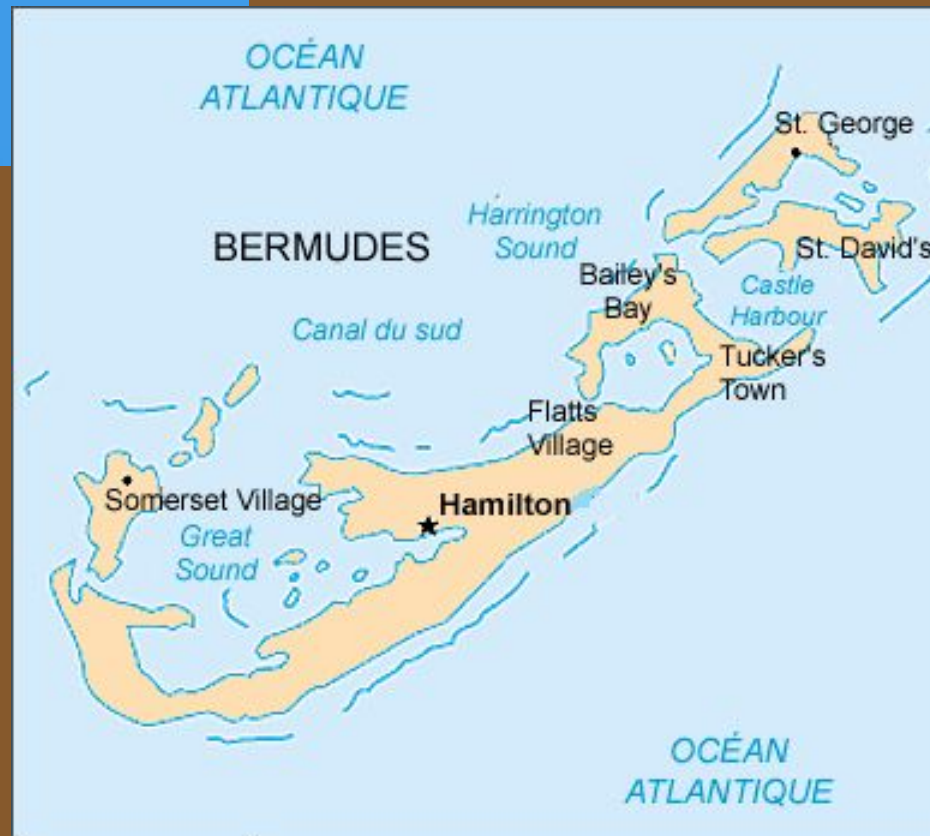
