Key Skills	Strong verbal and written communication skills, empathy, problem-solving skills*
Computer Skills	Medical software required to manage patients' charts*

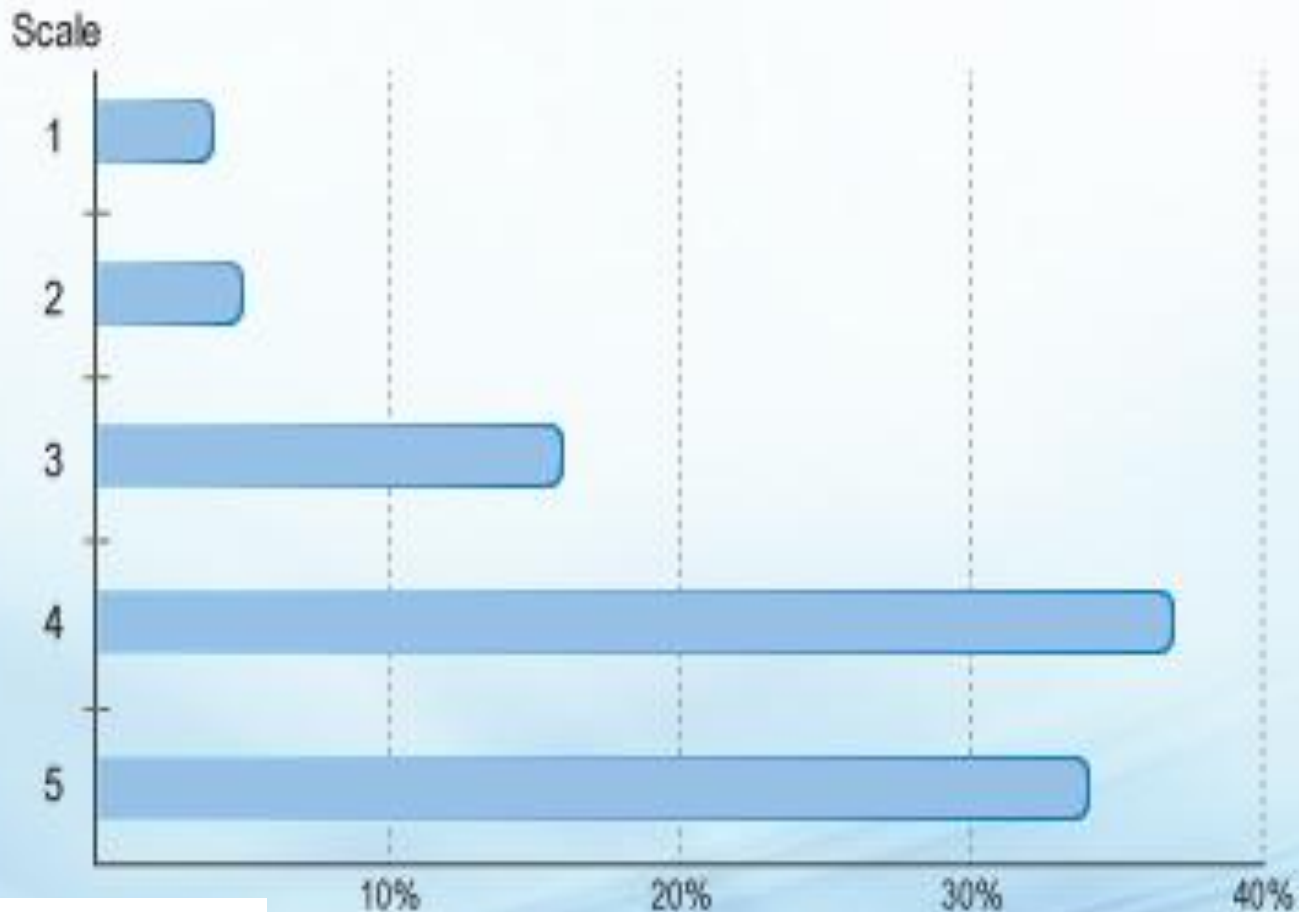

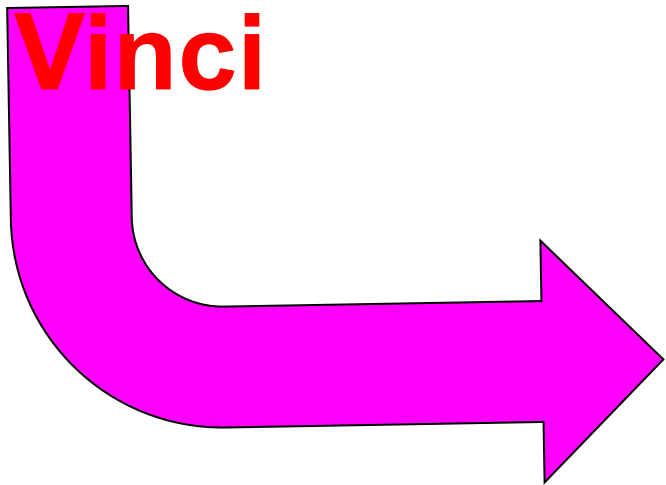

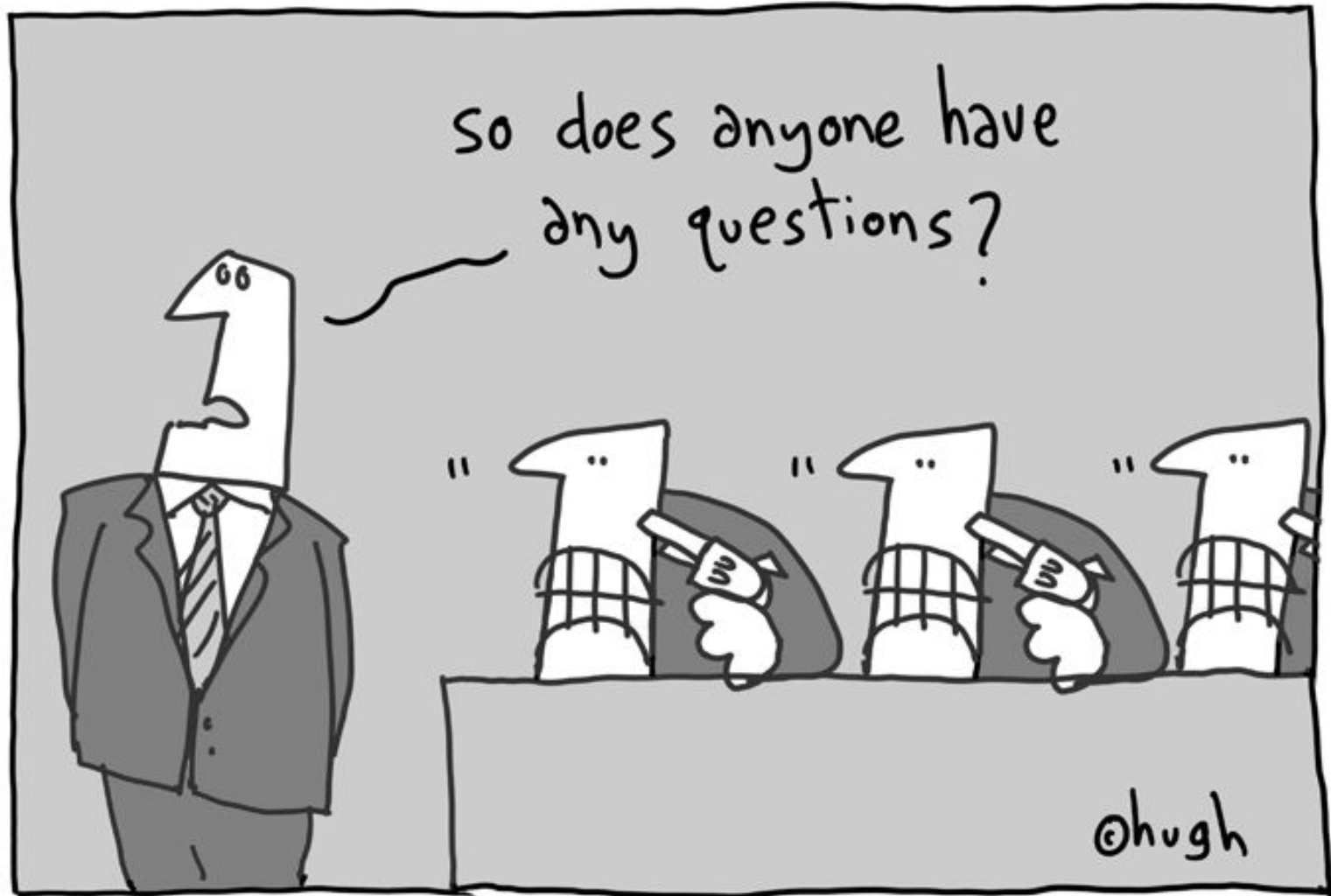
