Past (Indefinite) Simple - did	Past (Indefinite) Simple – was/were+ed/V3
You <b>planted</b> roses last year	The roses were planted last year by you.
She <b>planted</b> roses last year	The roses <b>were</b> <b>planted</b> last year by her.

Active voice	Passive voice
Past Continuous – was/were+ing	Past Continuous – was/were being+ed/V3
You were planting roses when he came	The roses were being planted by you when he came.
She was planting roses when he came	The roses <b>were</b> <b>being planted</b> by me <b>when</b> he came.

Active voice	Passive voice
Past Perfect – had+ed/V3	Past Perfect – had been+ed/V3
You had planted roses before he came.	The roses had been planted by you before he came.
She had planted roses before he came.	The roses had been planted by her before he came.

Active voice	Passive voice
Past Perfect Continuous – had been+ing	Past Perfect Continuous
You had been planting roses for 2 hours when he came.	NO
She had been planting roses for 2 hours when he came.	NO

Active voice	Passive voice
Future (Indefinite) Simple – shall/will	Future Simple – shall/will be+ed/V3
I shall plant roses tomorrow	The roses will be planted tomorrow by me.
She will plant roses tomorrow	The roses will be planted tomorrow by her.

Active voice	Passive voice
Future Continuous – shall/will be +ing	Future Continuous
I shall be planting roses <b>at this time</b> tomorrow.	NO
She will be planting roses <b>at this time</b> tomorrow.	NO

Active voice	Passive voice
Future Perfect – shall/will have+ed/V3	Future Perfect – shall/will have been+ed/V3
	The roses will have been planted tomorrow by 3 o'clock.
She will have planted roses tomorrow <b>by</b> 3 o'clock	The roses <b>will have</b> <b>been planted</b> tomorrow <b>by</b> 3 o'clock.

Active voice	Passive voice
Future Perfect Continuous (shall/will have been+ing)	Future Perfect Continuous
I shall have been planting roses for 4 hours, when he comes.	NO
She will have been planting roses <b>for</b> 4 hours, <b>when</b> he comes	NO
