PANCAKE TUESDAY

- Pancake Day is called Pancake Tuesday or Shrove Tuesday in the UK.
- It's a tradition to eat thin, flat pancakes on Pancake Day in England.
- The pancakes are topped with sugar and served with lemon juice. Sometimes people like to eat pancakes with sweet toppings, such as chocolate, jam or maple syrup.

Shrove Tuesday and Great Lent

- Shrove Tuesday is a Christian festival and traditional day of feasting.
- People celebrate it before great Lent. It lasts for 40 days.
- People fast during the Great Lent giving up chocolate or sweet, but in Russia we give up meat, milk and cottage cheese.

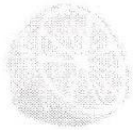

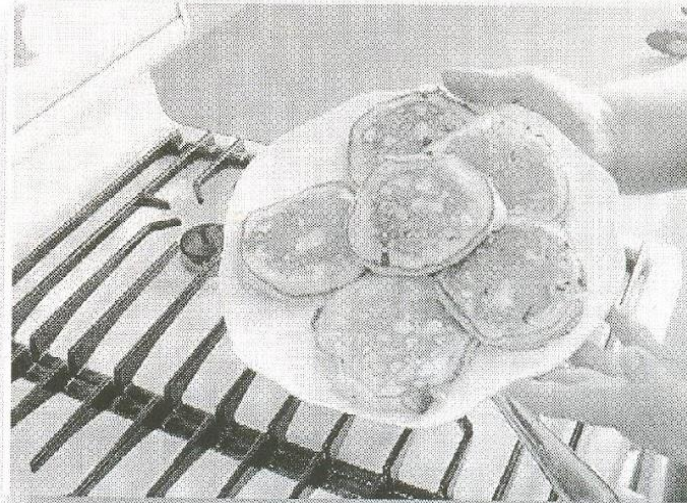

CHOCOLATE CHIP PANCAKES

INGREDIENTS

- * 3/4 cup of white flour
- * 1 1/2 tablespoons of white sugar
- * 3/4 teaspoon of baking powder
- * 1/4 teaspoon of salt
- * 1 1/2 tablespoons of melted butter
- * 7/8 cup of milk
- * 1 large egg
- * 1/4 teaspoon of vanilla
- * 2 teaspoons of vegetable oil
- * 4 tablespoons of chocolate chips

PANCAKE TUESDAY



METHOD

In a medium size bowl whisk together the dry ingredients: flour, sugar, baking powder and the salt.

In another bowl mix together the melted butter, milk, egg, and vanilla (wet ingredients).

Add the wet ingredients to the dry ingredients and whisk together until combined.

Pre-heat a large non-stick frying pan for 3-4 minutes on medium heat, and add 1 teaspoon of vegetable oil.

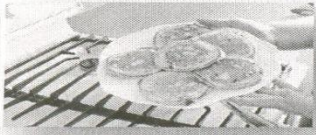
Using a $\frac{1}{4}$ cup measuring cup, scoop out the batter and pour it into the frying pan. Repeat so there are three pancakes in the pan.

Sprinkle about 1 tablespoon of chocolate chips on each pancake. Cook the pancakes until bubbles appear on the surface and start to pop. Flip the pancakes and cook until golden brown on the flip side.

Repeat with the remaining batter. Makes six small pancakes.

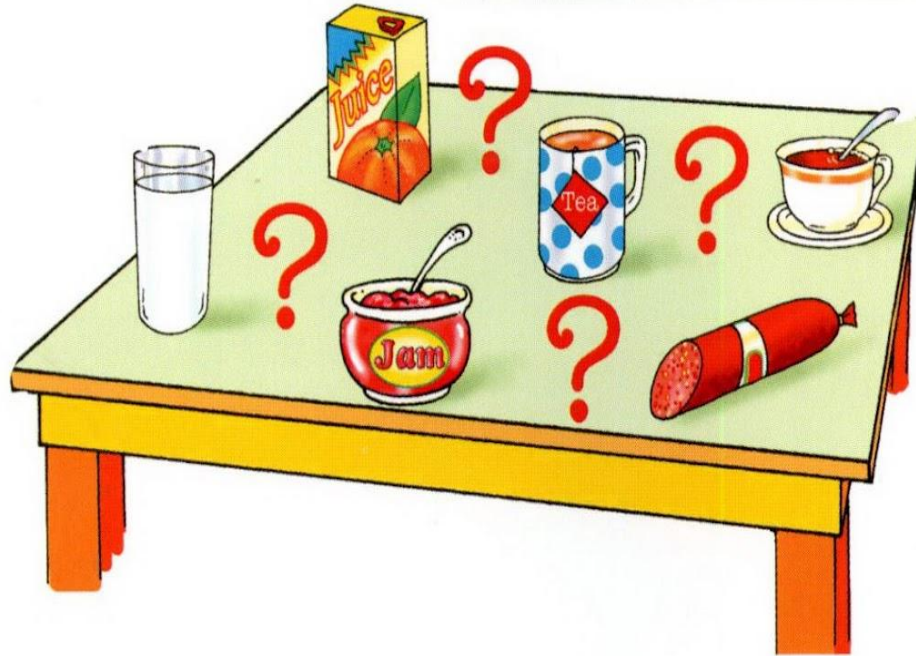


CHOCOLATE CHIP PANCAKES
