American writer, the largest representative of the so-called "lost generation" in the literature. The most famous Fitzgerald brought the novel "The Great Gatsby", published in 1925, as well as a number of novels and short stories about the American "jazz age" of the 1920s. The term "jazz era" or "the Jazz Age" was coined by Fitzgerald and designated period of American history since the end of World War I to the Great Depression of the 1930s.






## LITTLE ABOUT THE WRITER

❖ Fitzgerald was born on September 24, 1896 in St. Paul, Minnesota, in a wealthy Irish Catholic family. Before his birth, the family lost two children, so Francis Scott was a welcome child. His name he received in honor of his great-great-grandfather, the author of the U.S. National Anthem "The Banner, star-filled" Francis Scott Key.

Leonardo DiCaprio 's mother , Irmelin DiCaprio , nee Indenbirken , was born in the West German Op - Erkenschwick . Her father's name was William Indenbirken and mother - Russian Yelena Smirnova Stepanivna that after moving to Germany from the USSR got married and took her husband's surname Indenbirken . Himself Leonardo DiCaprio in a conversation with Vladimir Putin said that his grandfather was also Russian , and added: " So I'm not a quarter and half Russian ."*


*Future actor was named Leonardo thanks mother , who was visiting the museum in Italy and watched the work of the artist Leonardo da Vinci. When Leo was a year old , his parents divorced and his son stayed with his mother . He lived in several Los Angeles neighborhoods , such as Echo Park Avenue and 1874 Hillharst while his mother worked several jobs .*

# THE PLOT OF THE FILM.

- ❖ Nick Kerrauey , a graduate of Yale University and a veteran of the First World , is in a sanatorium , where is being treated for alcoholism. He tells about a man named Gatsby , whom fate brought him to New York. Nick is difficult to talk about it, and the doctor offers him describe this story on paper.
- ❖ Nick begins his narrative recollection of how in 1922 he moved from the Midwest to New York and rented a house in West Egge on Long Island . Nick visits the luxurious estate of Tom and Daisy Buchanan . Daisy was Nick's second cousin , and her husband , Tom, once played football at Yale (where he was nodding familiar with Nick ) , and now enjoys wealth. In this house, Nick meets Jordan Baker , Daisy's friend and the famous golfer . Jordan tells Nick that Tom has a mistress in New York .
- ❖ Meeting with the latest, Myrtle Wilson , the wife of an unsuspecting mechanic George , Tom rents an apartment in the city. Tom invites Nick there , where he also met with Catherine , her sister Myrtle , and the couple, McKee, Myrtle friends . The night ends with a general revelry and Myrtle broken nose , irritated Tom mentioning the name Daisy . Nick removed from this chaos with Mr. McKee.



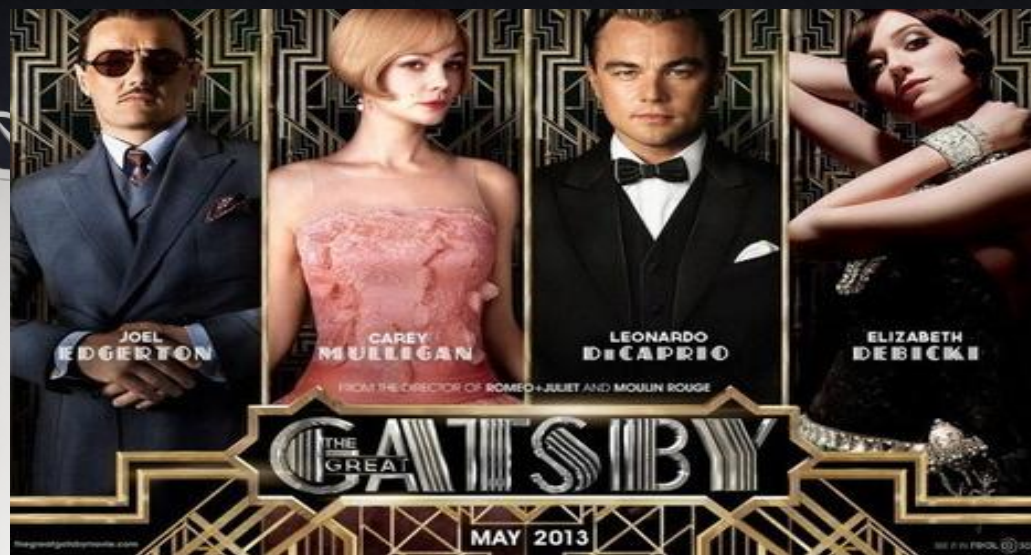
Nick was the nearest neighbor of Jay Gatsby, a very rich man, known to carry the chic fun parties in his huge mansion, every Saturday attended by hundreds of people. Soon the driver Gatsby Nick brought a formal invitation to one of these parties. Gatsby was a mystery man on the amount and source of enormous wealth which there were many rumors. Nick met none of the guests did not even know how Gatsby looks. During the party, a man learned Nick revealed that they odnopolchane. It turned out that the other person is Mr. Nick and Gatsby. Soon struck up a friendship between them. Nick was very surprised when Gatsby without explanation of his action told him the story of his rise up the social ladder, seemingly fictional. Nick meets Gatsby companion, dark businessman named Meyer Vulfshym.

Daisy , though fluctuating, but refuses to say it. Tom feels victory. He decides that Daisy and Gatsby back go together, and he , Nick and Jordan go to another machine.



At this time, George Wilson brawl with his wife , suspecting her of infidelity . She runs out of the house and knocked her to the death machine Gatsby, Daisy waged . The car carried away . Who were traveling behind Jordan , Nick and Tom noticed the dead . That recognizes her as his mistress. George distraught . He is obsessed with the idea that the driver of the vehicle , brought down Myrtle , was the one with whom she met . Tom says widower that this machine belongs to Gatsby . George Wilson finds and kills Gatsby in his pool and then commits suicide. Nick ring up friends Gatsby, but none of them does not come to the funeral. Tom and Daisy left , leaving the origin. Disgusted by the city and people Kerrauey Nick leaves New York.
