- 1905 October 17 - King's "Manifesto" (Kazakh intellectuals (Baitursynov, Bokeyhanov, Dulatov) has criticized the main points)
 - December 12, 1905 meeting held in Uralsk Kyrgyz intelligentsia called "congress of the five areas."
 - June 15, 1906 Bukeykhanov was unanimously elected deputy from Semipalatinsk Kazakhs in the first Russian State Duma.

- 1911 - Baitursynov published a book Masa (Mosquito) in Orenburg .
 - In 1914, Kazakhs Semipalatinsk A. Bukeyhanova elected their representative to the "Muslim Congress" held in the same year in Moscow and brought together 35 members of the Muslim peoples of Russia.
 - In 1913 A.Baytursynov wrote: "The very existence of the Kazakh nation was the major problem."

-
- 1913-1917 years. - Publication of the newspaper "Kazakh" (based on Arabic script).
 - Held 21-28 July 1917 in Orenburg I-th All-Kazakh Congress.
 - November 21, 1917 the newspaper "Kazakh" has published a draft of the party program.
 - Results of the elections to the Constituent Assembly, which took place in late 1917, for example, in Semipalatinsk most votes won Alash Party - 3 thousand 304.

- November 27, 1917 at the IV Congress of emergency Allmuslim held in Kokand was announced Turkestan autonomy
 - March 1917 - created the Kazakh Committee.

 - December 05-13 - Second All-Kazakh Congress in Orenburg.
 - March 5, 1920 liquidated the Bolshevik Military Revolutionary Committee to manage the corner of the Kirghiz.
