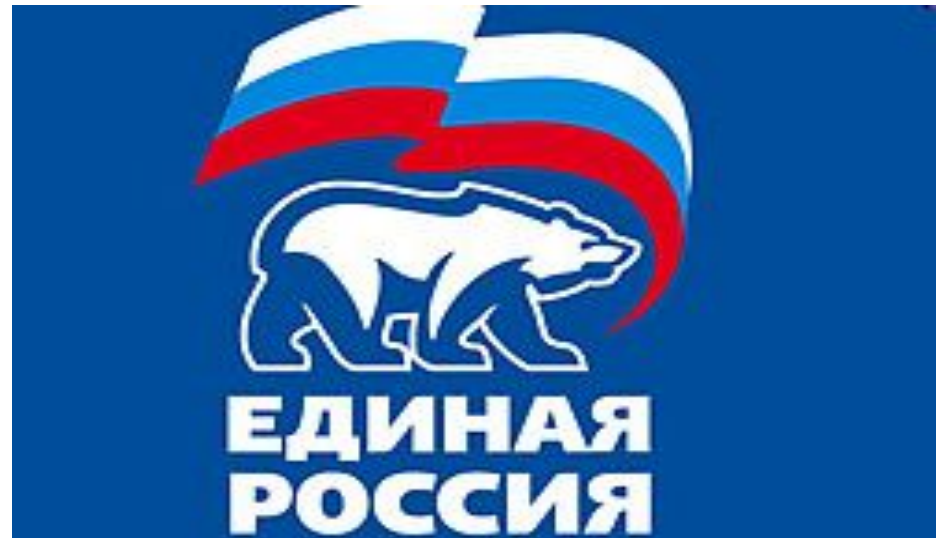


The President of the Russian Federation

Political affiliation

None of the Russian presidents to date ever were a member of a political party in office or later. However, former (and now incoming) president Vladimir Putin is the nominal head of the government-created United Russia, the dominant Russian political party.

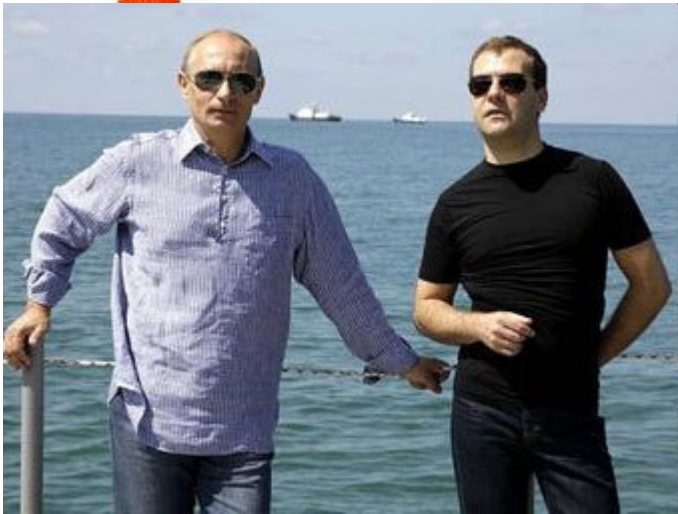
Air transport services for the President are provided by airline company Rossiya.

She is the first monarch to send her children to boarding schools in order to remove them from the ever-probing media.
