Britain is no exception. I want to hold a competition to see which of these laws are the most stupid.



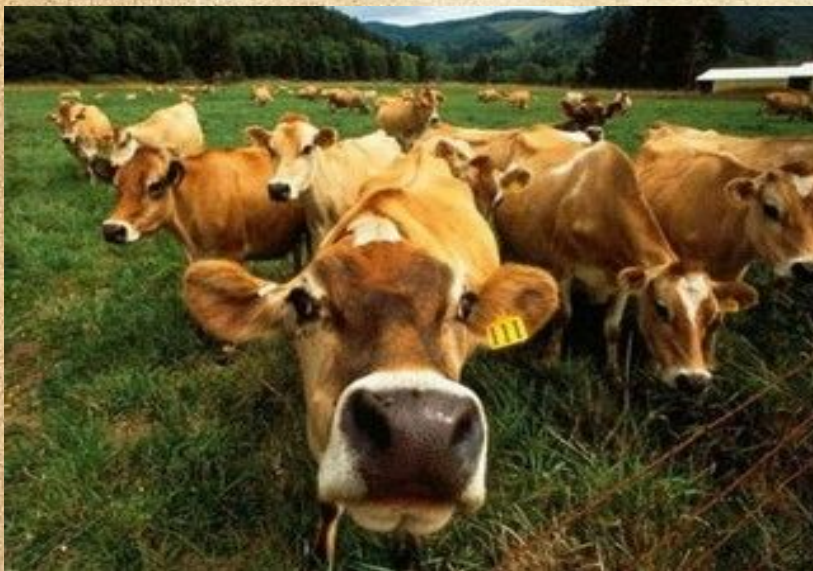
# Top-10 the most ridiculous laws in the UK
