□ There are most of Central and Western Europe, north of the border come to Britain, the north-western part of the Netherlands and Norway. In eastern border runs along the southern Lithuania, Belarus, Ukraine bordering the eastern regions of Russia (Belgorod region). In Ukraine, distributed almost throughout, but the largest number in Polissya and forest-steppe and in the wooded areas of the Crimea. The steppe zone is found on the banks of rivers.



LIVING IN NATURE

Appearance after hibernation depends on geographic latitude, specificity spring period and usually occurs in the second half of March - early April. The first appearance local spawning occurred in setting water temperature 4-6 ° C, the mass spawning population at 9-10 ° C, and start laying eggs - to achieve water temperature 13 ° C.
