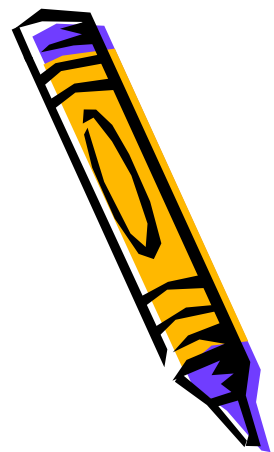
Sentry: *Who comes there?*

St.Paul's Cathedral

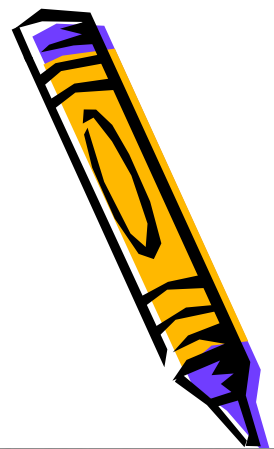
He knew that he would redesigned St.Paul's Cathedral before The Great Fire.

Only his third project was accepted by the Government



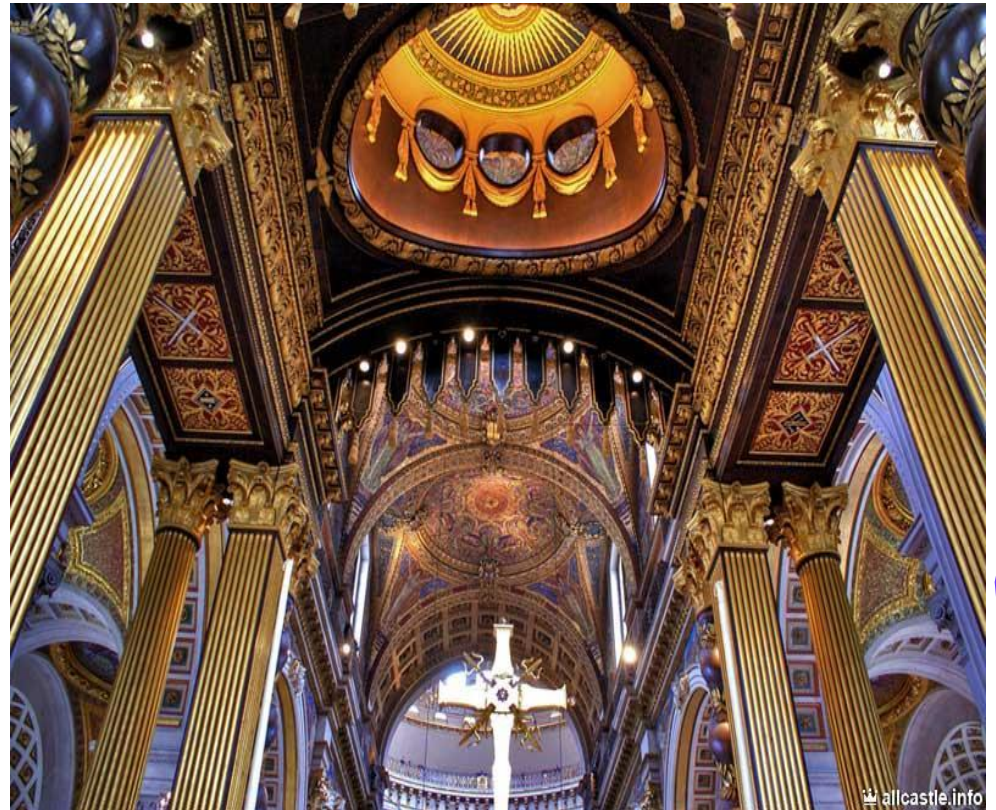

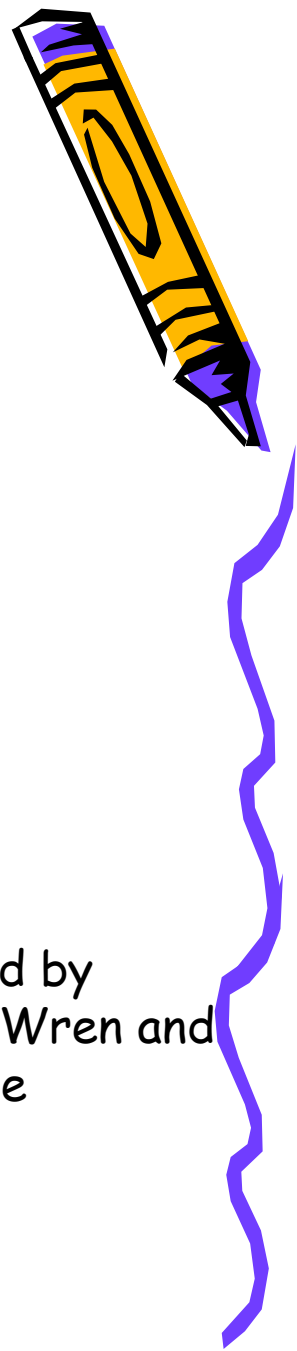


The Monument

Also Known as

The Monument

The height is 61.57 m. Its height marks its distance from the site in Pudding Lane of the shop of Thomas Farynor, the king's baker, where the Great Fire began.



The Monument



Nowadays 360 degree panoramic camera was installed on top of the Monument. Updated every minute And running 24 hours a day, it provides a record of weather, building and ground activity in the City.
