COPYRIGHT IS A FORM OF PROTECTION GIVEN TO AUTHORS/CREATIONS OF ORIGINAL WORKS.



What is protected?

- literary works (e.g., all text, including computer software);
- musical works;
- dramatic works;
- pantomimes and choreographic works;
- pictorial, graphic, and sculptural works;
- motion pictures and other audiovisual works;
- sound recordings;
- architectural works.



What is not protected?

- ideas, concepts, or discoveries;
- titles, names, short phrases, and slogans;
- works that are not fixed in a tangible form of expression such as improvised speech or dance;
- works consisting entirely of information that is commonly available and contains no originality;
- anything written or created by the US government.

How Copyright protects works

 Copyright protects "original works of authorship" that are fixed in "a tangible form of expression." The fixed form does not have to be directly perceptible so long as it can be communicated with the aid of a machine or other device.
