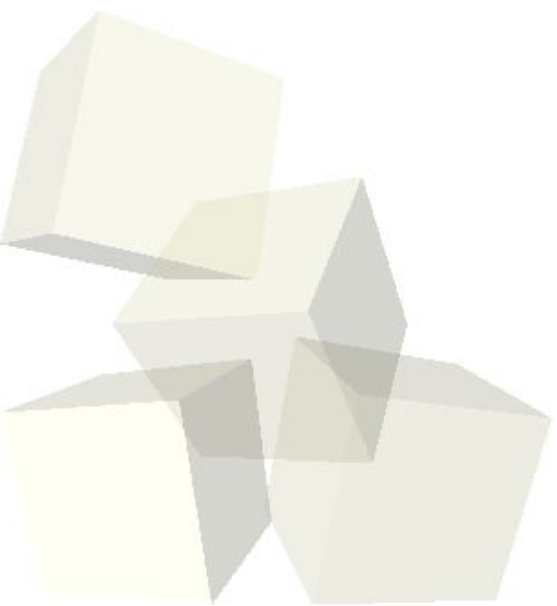

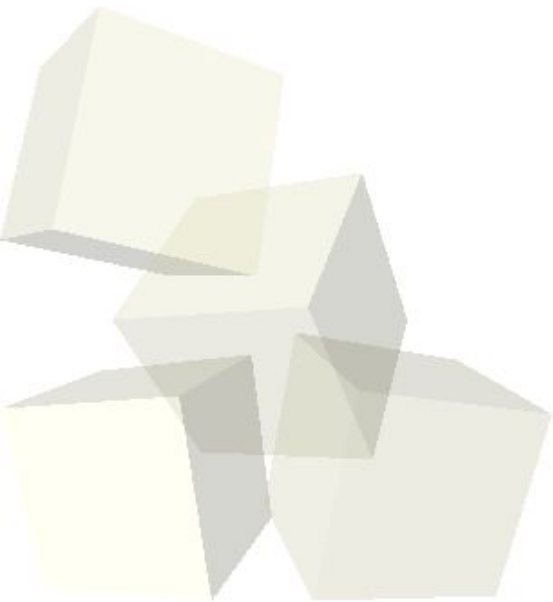

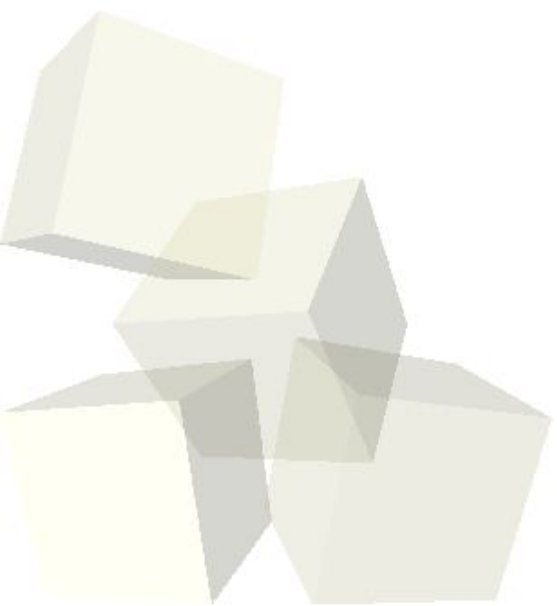

Grammatical Characteristics of the Word *Foot*

- Intransitive
- Irregular





This is a polysemantic word.

It's primary meaning is to leg

«A boy lamped to his feet.»

The secondary meaning is to waite.

«The boy was too tall for his age and he was three foot two in this shoes.»

The thirdly meaning is to

«As the foot mountains, at the foot of the page...»

On foot = walking, not riding





Set-phrases and Idioms

1) **Be off on the wrong foot** (**испортить отношения**)

e.g. He tried to reason with his sister, but it seemed that they were off on the wrong foot already.

2) **A foot in the door** (**благоприятная возможность**)

e.g. "I think you can get a foot in the door if you act quickly."

3) **Foot the bill** (**заплатить за что-либо**)

e.g. The Frawlys hoped the company would foot the bill for the ransom of eight million dollars.

4) **Get off on the wrong foot** (**неудачно начать**)

e.g. "I think you got off on the wrong foot with your classmates, that's why they don't like you."

5) **Have one foot in the grave** (**"быть одной ногой в могиле"**)

e.g. The woman was very sick and had one foot in the grave.



6) **Put one's best foot forward** (**стараться быть на высоте**)

e.g. It was the necessity to put her best foot forward that was really troubling her.

7) **Put one's foot down** (**положить конец, занять твёрдую позицию**)

e.g. This has gone far enough; he is going to put his foot down.

8) **Put one's foot in one's mouth** ("**сесть в лужу**")

e.g. He was afraid lest he should put his foot in his mouth, so he decided to keep silent.

9) **The shoe is on the other foot** (**положение изменилось**)

e.g. The shoe is on the other foot now that my sister is the only money earner in the family after her husband's death.

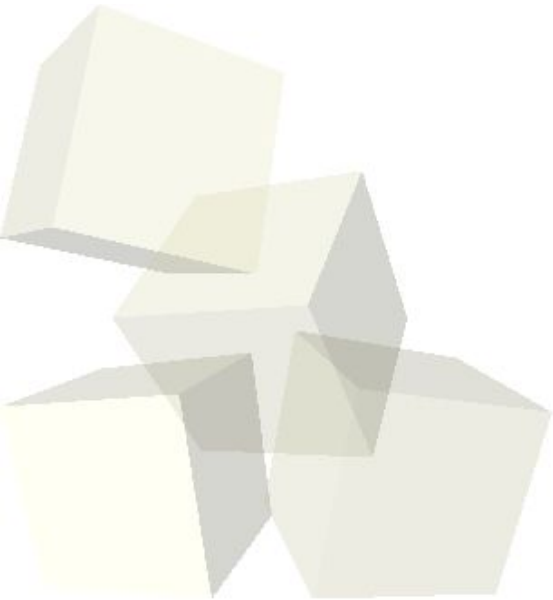

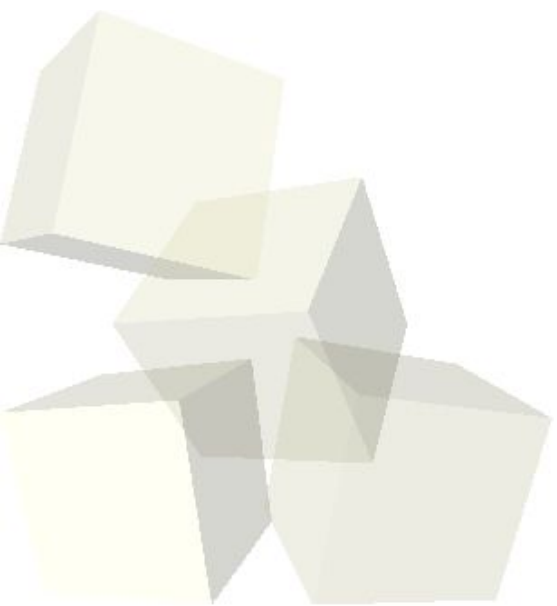

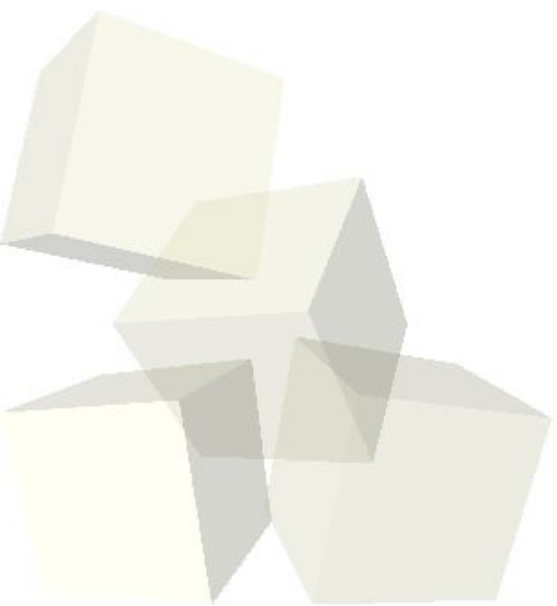
