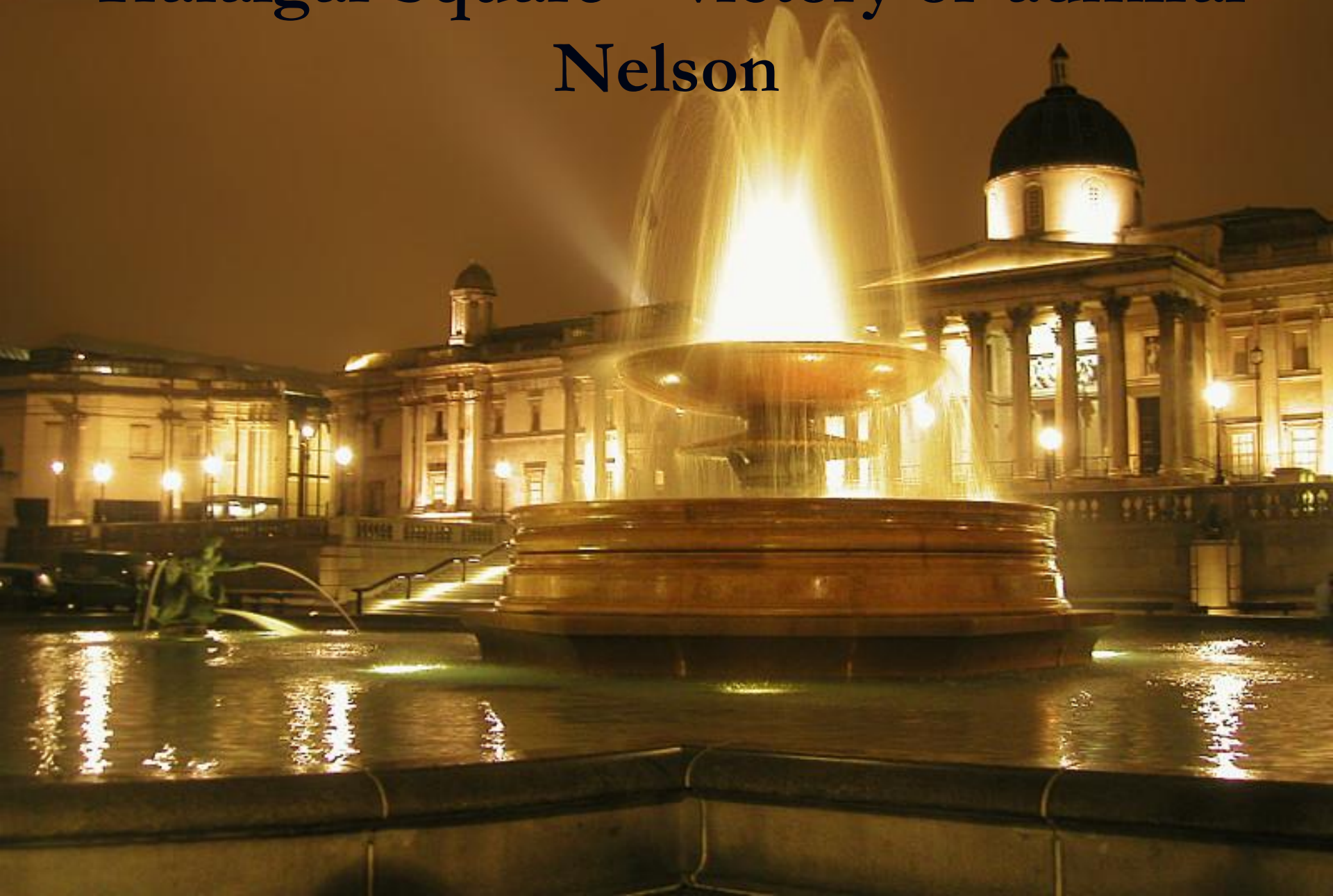
St. Paul's Cathedral – One of the largest cathedrals in the world



The Tower Bridge – beautiful monument above Thames



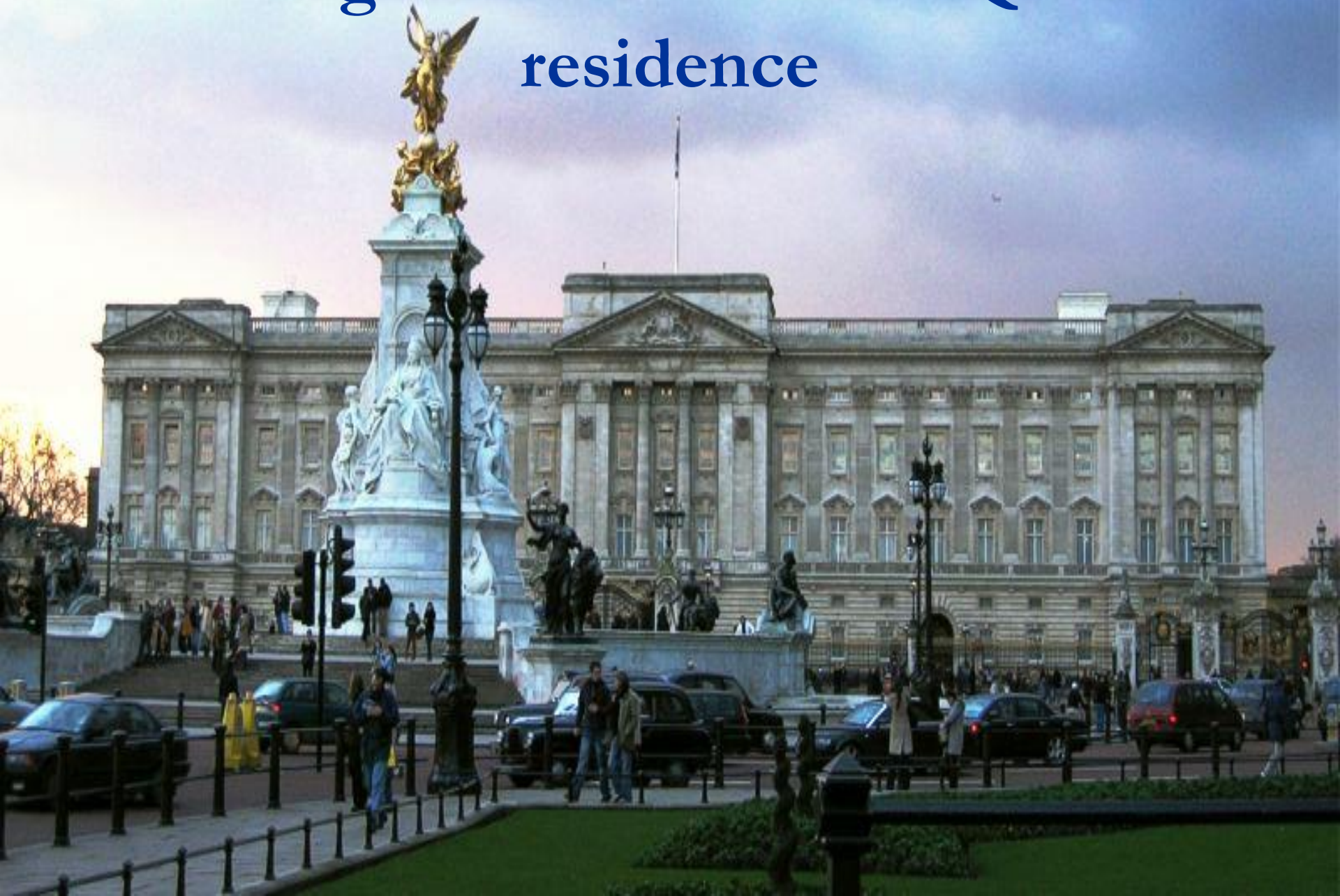
Trafalgar Square – victory of admiral Nelson
