OXFORD

Oxford University is the oldest and most famous in Britain. It was founded in the 12-th century and is a collection of colleges with more then 12,000 students and 1,000 teachers.







CAMBRIDGE



Cambridge is the second oldest. It was founded in the 13-th century and has 27 colleges





In the UK higher education academic year begins in October and consists of the trimesters of 8-10 weeks each.

Summer holidays last for four months, from June 1 to September 31.







In most cases the examinations shall be after the 1st and 3rd year of study, usually two major exams, the results of which are awarded the degree.
