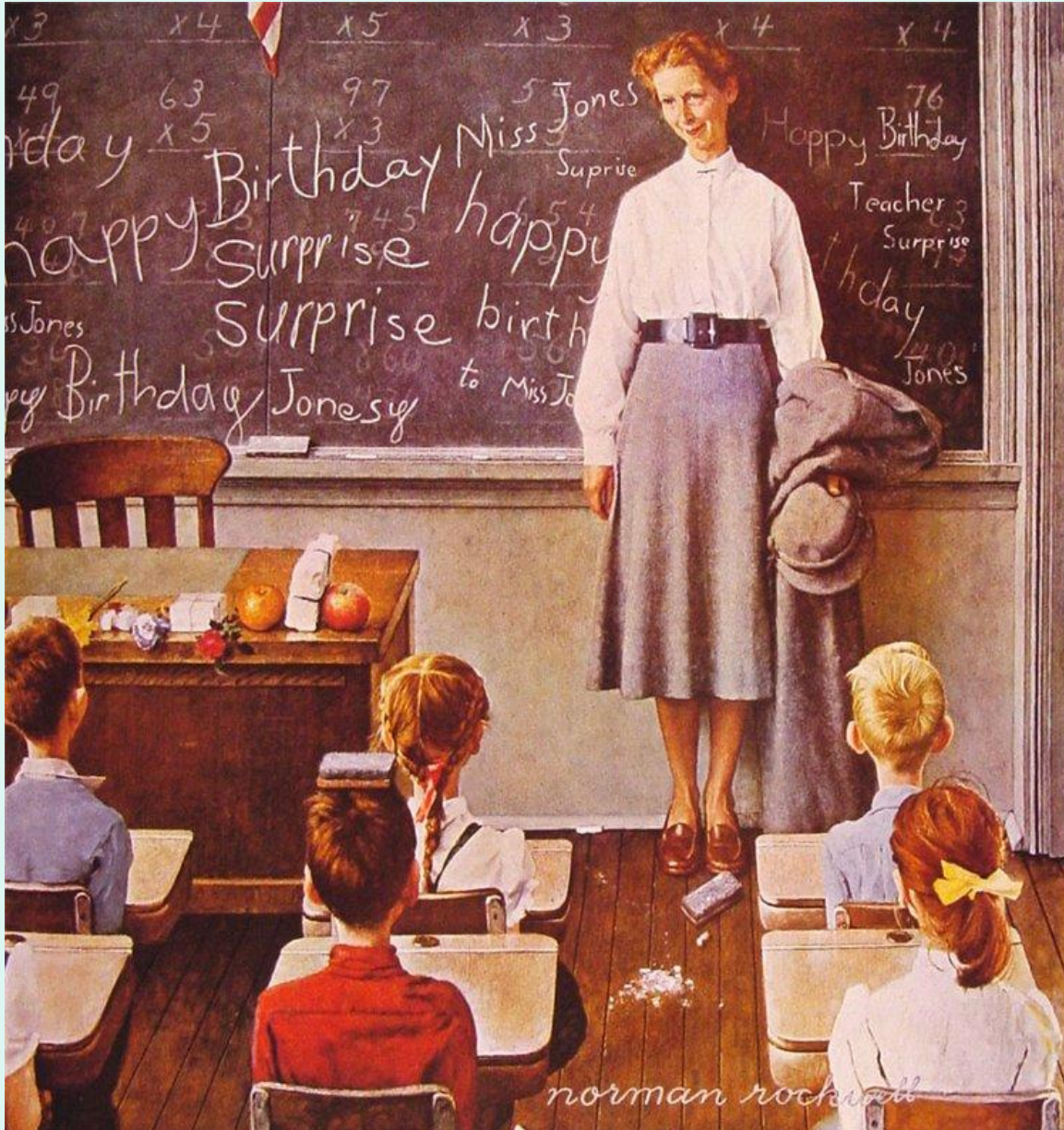

On the one hand, this job is important and noble, but, on the other hand, it is very stressful and hard.





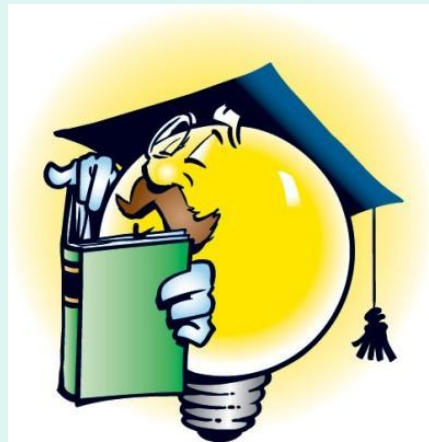
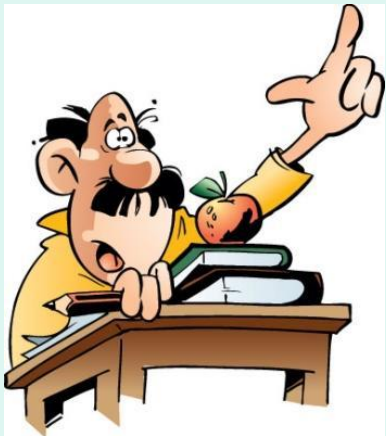
