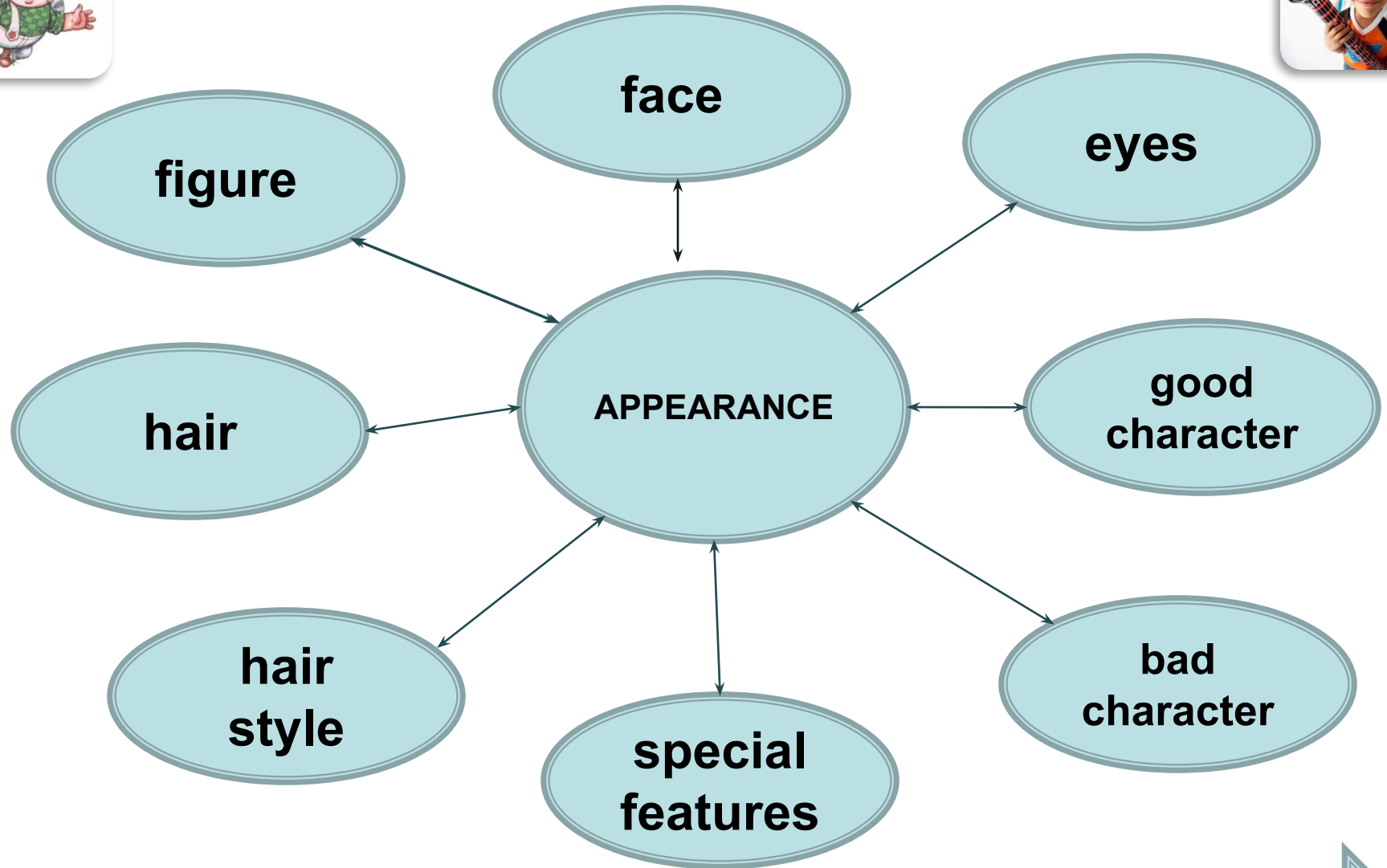

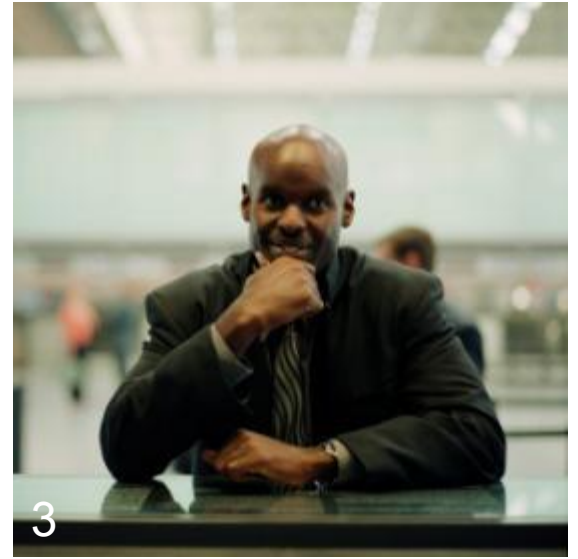
Communicative Task
