

- One of the treasures of the Abbey is the oaken Coronation Chair made in 1300.
- Near the West Door of the Abbey the UNKNOWN WARRIOR lies.





LONDON DUNGEON

- The London Dungeon is a popular tourist attraction, which recreates various gory and macabre historical events in a humorous style.
- *Open hours*: every day 9:30-18: 30
- Price: adults -23 pounds, children under 16 17 pounds



TRAFALGAR SQUARE

 Trafalgar Square is the natural center of London.



MADAME TUSSAUDS MUSEUM

- Madame Tussauds in London is a museum and tourist attraction in Central London, housed in the former London Planetarium. It is known for recreating life size wax models of celebrities.
- Open hours: from Monday to Friday 10:00-!7:30, On Saturdays and Sundays 9:30-17:30
- Price: adults 28 pounds, children-24 pounds.



SHERLOCK HOLMES MUSEUM

- Dedicated to the famous fictional detective Sherlock Holmes, the Museum was opened in 1990 in central London close to Regent's Park and is situated in Baker Street, 221B
- Open hours: every day 9:30-18:00
- Price: adults 6 pounds, children- 4 pounds







ST. PAUL IS CATHEDRAL

- Open hours: from Monday –Saturday 8:30-16:30.
- Price: adults-14 pounds, students 13 pounds, children- 5 pounds.










WHISPERING GALLERY IN ST. PAUL IS CATHEDRAL
