FORM:


Verb TO BE (simple present)

+

MAIN VERB ending in -ING

USE:

☐ To talk about actions happening at or around the moment of speaking (temporary actions)





·Some verbs ending in -e drop the -e and take the -ing suffix

sit ⇒ sitting

swim ⇒ swimming

but open ⇒ opening

write ⇒ writing take ⇒ taking but see ⇒ seeing

Verbs ending in -I, double the -I and take the -ing suffix

travel ⇒ travelling

lie ⇒lying die ⇒ dying

·Verbs ending in -ie, drop the -ie and take -y + ing
