## 1) Mom warned me, "Don't eat so much junk food".

Answer:

Mom warned me <u>not to eat</u> so much junk food.

2) "We've never been here before", the couple said.

Answer:

The couple said (that) they <u>had never been</u>
<u>there</u> before.

## 3) My uncle asked me "Why do you want to study Spanish?"

Answer:

My uncle asked me why *I wanted* to study Spanish.

4) The child said, "I'm not hungry now".

Answer:

The child said (that) <u>he was</u> not hungry <u>at that moment.</u>

5) "Don't talk to strangers", my father told me.

Answer:

My father told me <u>not to talk</u> to strangers.

6) "Can you meet me at the station?", my daughter asked me.

Answer:

My daughter asked me <u>if I could meet</u>

<u>her</u> at the station.

7) My co-worker said, "I won't tell anyone".

Answer:

My co-worker said (that) she wouldn't tell anyone.

8) My spouse said, "I ate before you arrived".

Answer:

My spouse said (that) <u>he had eaten</u> before <u>I</u> arrived.

9) My niece said, "I may bring someone with me to the party".

Answer:

My niece said (that) she may bring someone with <u>her</u> to the party.

10) "Where is my laptop?", my sister asked.

Answer:

My sister asked where <u>her</u> laptop <u>was</u>.

## 11) "Has Ms. Lee talked to Kevin?", my friends asked me.

Answer:

My friends asked me <u>if</u> Ms. Lee <u>had</u> to Kevin.

#### 12) "What time is it?", a passerby asked me.

Answer:

A passerby asked me what time *it was*.

#### 13) Mom told me, "set the table for dinner."

Answer:

Mom told me *to* set the table for dinner.

### 14) My aunt asked me "Have you finished doing the dishes?"

Answer:

My aunt asked me *if I had* finished doing the dishes.

15) The porter said, "I'll help you".

Answer:

The porter said (that) <u>he would</u> help <u>me</u>.

## 16) "I get up every morning at 7 o'clock", my personal trainer said.

Answer:

My personal trainer said (that) <u>he gets</u>
<u>up</u> every morning at 7 o'clock.

## 17) My brother told me, "I wish I had bought that car".

Answer:

My brother told me <u>he wishes</u> he had bought that car.

## 18) My grandparents said, "We've been living here for a long time".

Answer:

My grandparents said (that) *they had been living* here for a long time.

## 19) Dad asked me, "Have you already walked the dogs?"

Answer:

Dad asked me *if I had* already walked the dogs.

## 20) My sister said, "I'm studying English at the moment."

Answer:

My sister said (that) she was studying English at that moment.

# 21) My neighbor asked me, "What did your sister say?"

Answer:

My neighbor asked me what <u>my</u> sister <u>had</u> said.

## 22) My boss asked me, "What are you doing?".

Answer:

My boss asked me what *I was doing*.

## 23) My best friend said, "I spent all my money on a car".

Answer:

My best friend said (that) <u>he had spent</u> all <u>his</u> money on a car.

# 24) My cousin said, "I want to visit my grandmother this weekend."

Answer:

My cousin said (that) she wanted to visit her grandmother that weekend.

## 25) My classmate asked me, "When is your birthday?"

Answer:

My classmate asked me when <u>my</u> birthday <u>was.</u>

#### 26) Dad asked me, "Are you going to have lunch at home?"

Answer:

Dad asked me *if I was going* to have lunch at home.

### 27) My English teacher asked me, "Did you do your homework?"

Answer:

My English teacher asked <u>me if I had</u> <u>done</u> my homework.

### 28) My brother said, "I don't know where my shoes are."

Answer:

My brother said (that) <u>he didn't know</u> where <u>his</u> shoes <u>were</u>.
