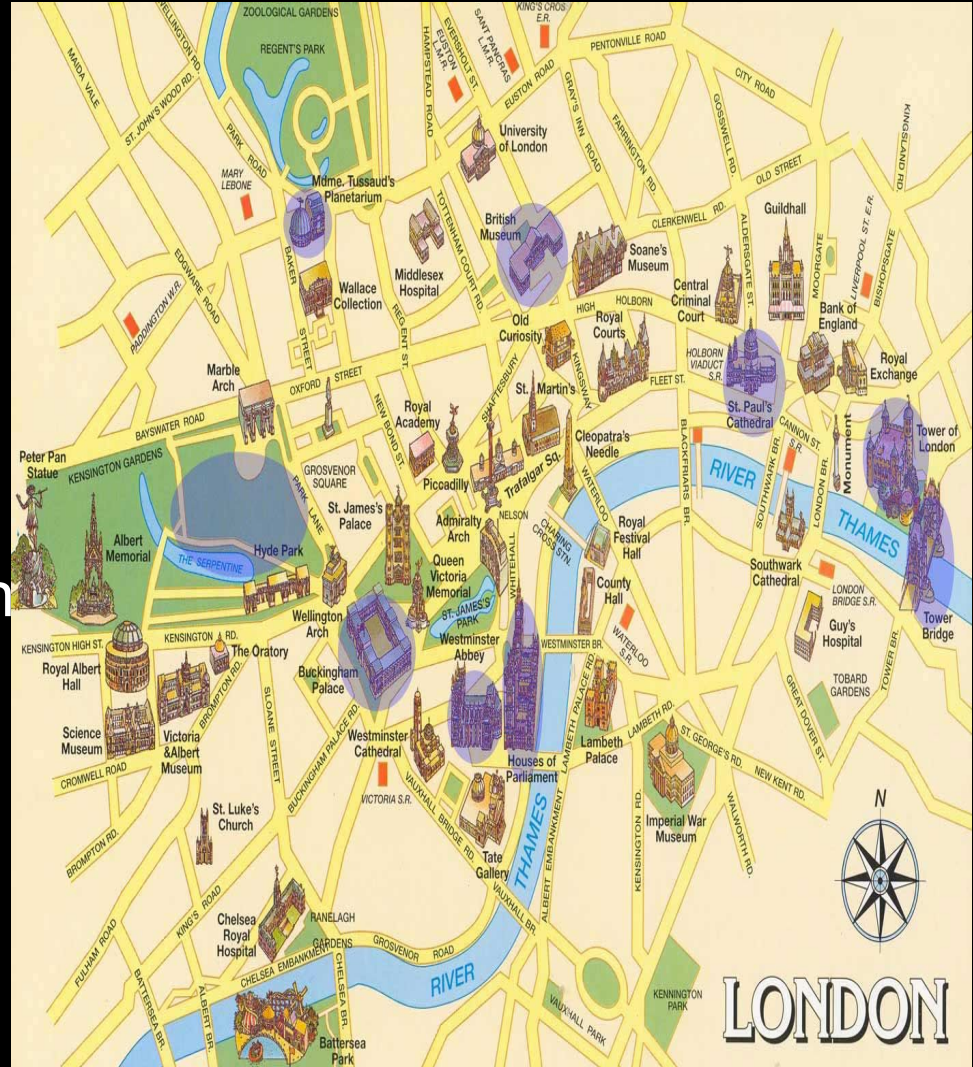
# *National holidays*

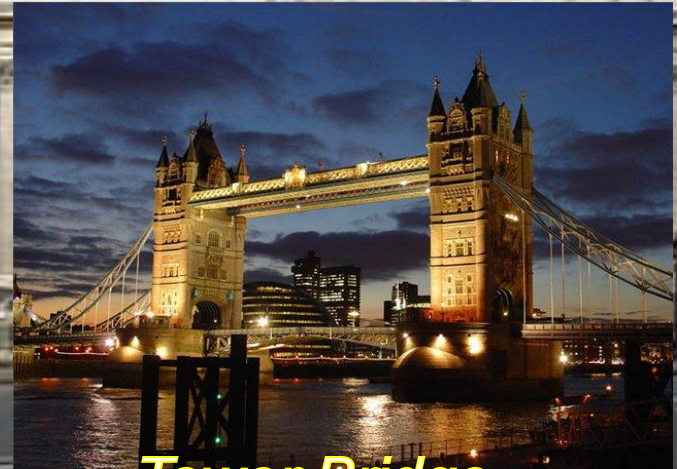


# *Sights in London*

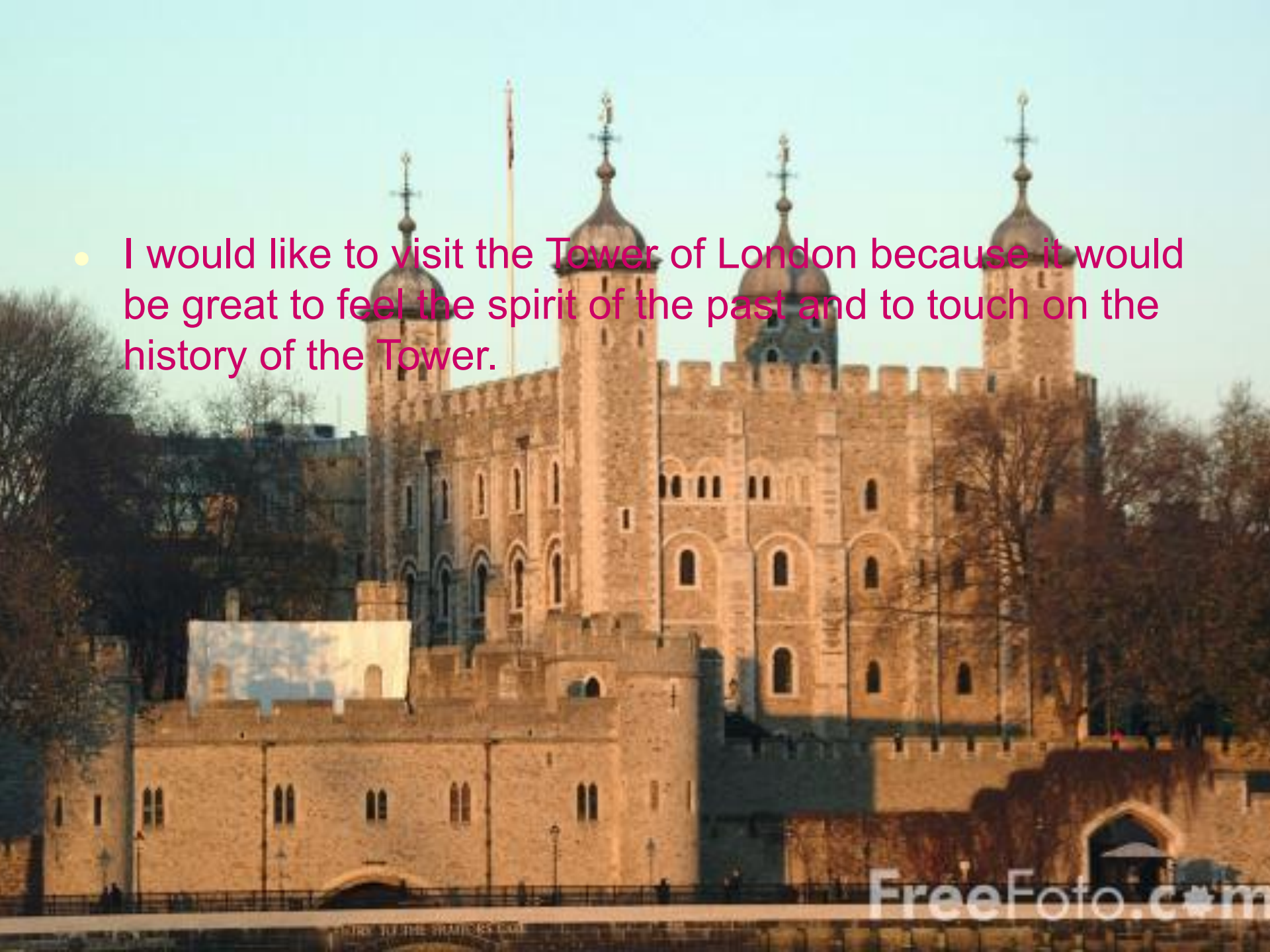




There is even a special keeper-
