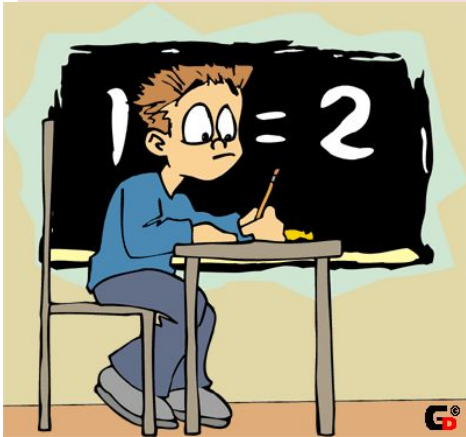

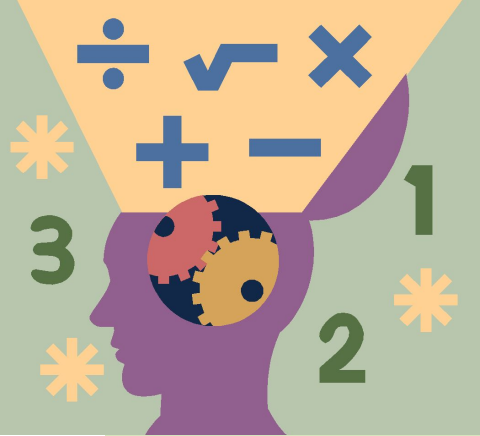

Present Simple

affirmative

I, we, you, they - **V**₁

I go to school every day.

He, she, it - **V**_s, **V**_{es}

He goes to school every day.

Present Simple question

Present Simple

negative

I, we, you, they - **don't V₁**

I don't play chess

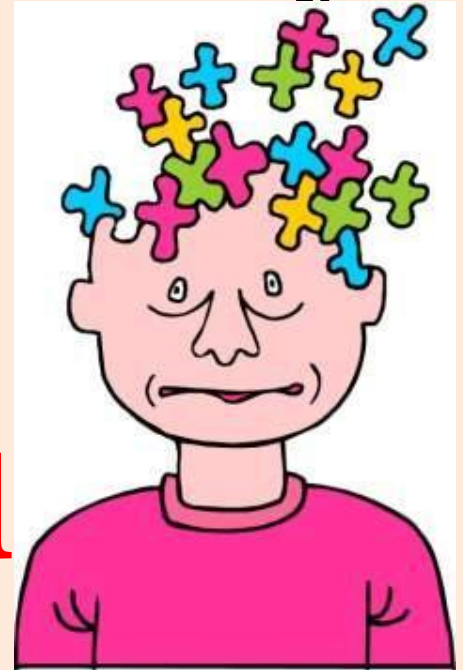
He, she, it – **doesn't V₁**

He doesn't play chess

“Yes/no” (I, you, we, they)

Do I go to school every day?

Do you often read books?



“Yes/no” (he, she, it)

**Does she go to school
every day?**

**Does he usually play
in the yard?**

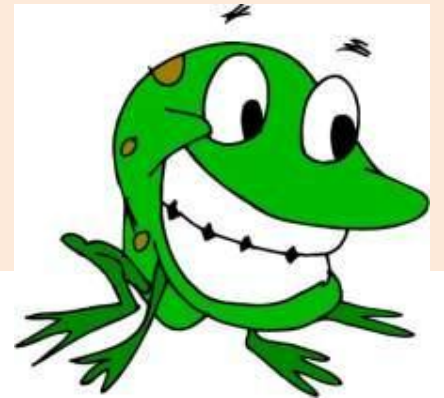
