


Present Simple negative

I, we, you, they - **don't V**1 <u>I don't play chess</u> He, she, it – **doesn't V**1

He doesn't play chess

"Yes/no" (I, you, we, they)

Do I go to school every day?

Do you often read

"Yes/no" (he, she, it) **Does** she go to school every day? **Does** he usually play in the yard?



"Wh" (I, you, we, they) I go to school every day. Where do I go every day? Why do I go to school every day?




"Wh" (he, she, it) He usually plays in the yard. Where does he usually play? Why does he usually play in the yard?
