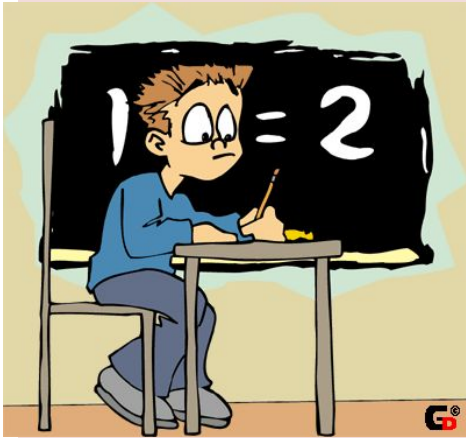

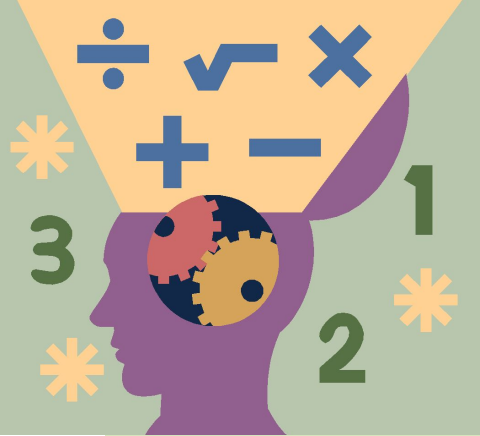

Present Simple

affirmative

I, we, you, they - **V₁**

I go to school every day.

He, she, it - **V_s, V_{es}**

He goes to school every day.

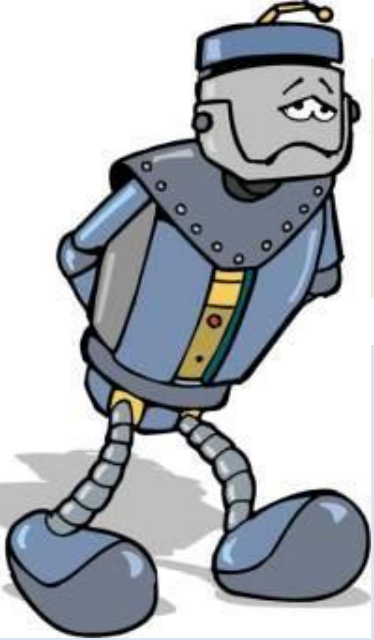

Present Simple

negative

I, we, you, they - **don't V₁**

I don't play chess

He, she, it – **doesn't V₁**

He doesn't play chess

“Yes/no” (I, you, we, they)

Do I **go** to school every day?

Do you often **read** books?



“Yes/no” (he, she, it)

Does she **go** to school
every day?

Does he usually **play**
in the yard?



“Wh” (I, you, we, they)

I go to school every day.

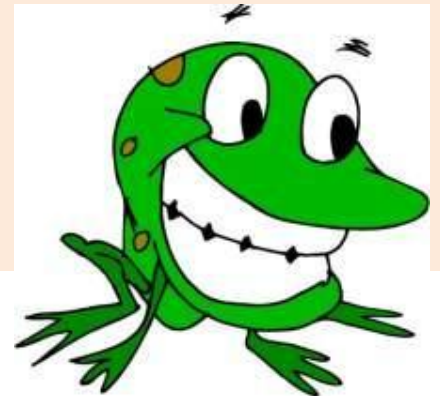
