In 1810 and 1820-ies the park was planted by John Nash, he built a palace and a lot of villas for the Prince Regent's family and his friends. In 1838 it was opened for visitors. From 1836 to 1861, the park worked as Bishop's Observatory.

Description.

- Regent's Park is a popular place where a lot of visitors can spend time and have a rest. Everyone can take part in many activities, such as tennis, football, hockey, Australian rules football, rugby and running. By the way the park took part in the 2012 Summer Olympics.
