The Prepositional Case

The uses of the prepositional case:

It is used after certain prepositions:

в = in, at

он живёт в Москве = he lives in Moscow

на = on, at

они играют на стадионе = they are playing at the stadium

Remember: в / на + acc = to
(place)

Он ездит в Москву

Они ходят на стадион

The uses of the prepositional case:

It is used after certain prepositions:

о (об *) = about, concerning

Я думаю о работе = I think about work

- об is used when following adjective or noun begins with vowel (художник говорит об искусстве = the artist is talking about art)
- обо мне = about me

при = at the time of, in the presence of

при Николае Первом - during the reign of
Nicholas the Great

Nouns and the prepositional case - it's easy!

- Nouns which end consonant: add **-e**
- Nouns which end a/ я/ o: remove last letter and add **-e**

- Лондон → в Лондон**e**
- Музей → в музе**e**
- Москва → в Москв**e**
- Письмо → в письм**e**
- спальня → в спальн**e**

Exceptions:

Сад - в саду

Лес - в лесу

Угол - в углу

Берег - на
берегу

Nouns and the prepositional case - it's easy!

- Ending -ь
masculine: remove -ь, add -е
feminine: remove -ь, add -и

кремль (m) → в кремле

живопись (f) → о живописи

Nouns and the prepositional case - it's easy!

- If the noun ends **-ие/ -ия**:
remove **-ие/ -ия**, add **-ии**

здание → в здани**ии**

Англия → в Англи**ии**

В or на?

В with enclosed spaces or buildings

На with open spaces and activities/events

В школе - in school

На работе - at work
